22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Human Services - Division of Mental Health Services for the
26 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
27 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification
28 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor,
29 and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to
30 which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be
31 exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation
32 Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed
33 by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act
34 (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

11 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MENTAL
13 HEALTH SERVICES - ALLOCATION RESTRICTION AND TRANSFER PROVISION. Of the
14 amounts allocated in the MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES - ALLOCATION RESTRICTIONS
15 section above, it is the intent of the General Assembly that such amounts are
16 to be the maximum expended in the applicable fiscal year from the funds as
17 appropriated for State Assistance in the Mental Health Services - Community
18 Mental Health Centers appropriation for the benefit of the appropriate
19 program so enumerated. Provided, however, in the event that unforeseen
20 circumstances occur in either fiscal year which would necessitate a transfer
21 of the maximum allocation provided the MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES - ALLOCATION
22 RESTRICTIONS section above from one or more programs to another program or
23 programs as enumerated in the MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES - ALLOCATION
24 RESTRICTIONS section above, the Mental Health Services Division with the
25 approval of the Director of the Department of Human Services shall make its
26 request known, and the reasons thereof, to the Office of Budget, Department
27 of Finance and Administration in such form and detail as may be required by
28 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. If approved, such transfer approval

1 HEALTH SERVICES - LEGISLATIVE AUDIT OF MENTAL HEALTH CENTERS. Every Mental
 2 Health Center eligible to receive any of the funds appropriated for State
 3 Assistance in the Mental Health Services - Community Mental Health Centers
 4 appropriation in this Act shall, as a condition of receiving any such funds,
 5 be subject to an annual audit of the overall operation of such Mental Health
 6 Center by the Division of Legislative Audit. The Mental Health Centers shall
 7 submit a budget to the Mental Health Services Division, Department of Human
 8 Services, and the Arkansas Legislative Council and go through the budget
 9 procedures process in the same manner as State departments, agencies,
 10 institutions, boards and commissions. Budgets shall be submitted based on
 11 operating revenues and expenses of each Center and each Center shall provide
 12 information related to financial status requested by the Legislative Council

17 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

 19 HEALTH SERVICES - APPORTIONMENT OF FUNDS. All funds appropriated under the
 20 provisions of the State Assistance line item in the Mental Health Services -
 21 Community Mental Health Centers appropriation in this Act shall be
 22 apportioned on the basis of three dollars and six cents (\$3.06) per capita
 23 for fiscal year ~~2001-2002~~ 2003-2004 and three dollars and six cents (\$3.06)
 24 per capita for fiscal year ~~2002-03~~ 2004-2005 or so much thereof as funds
 25 shall become available. Additional funds shall be apportioned on the basis

34 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MENTAL
 36 HEALTH SERVICES - GRANTS-IN-AID CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING FUNDS. Only

1 locally-operated Centers and Clinics licensed or certified by the Mental
2 Health Services Division are eligible to receive funds appropriated for State
3 Assistance in the Mental Health Services - Community Mental Health Centers
4 appropriation in this Act, and as a condition of receiving such funds they
5 shall:

6 (1) Meet minimum standards of performance in the delivery of Mental Health
7 Services as defined by the Department of Human Services, Mental Health
8 Services Division. Such standards will identify priority and/or target
9 populations to be served. The standards shall describe procedures for
10 assuring timely service delivery to clients who are within the custody of the
11 Department of Human Services when such clients are referred to a duly
12 certified center or clinic. Provided further, all such priorities, policies
13 and procedures shall be reviewed by the House Aging, Children & Youth,
14 Legislative and Military Affairs Committee and the Senate Children and Youth
15 Committee.

16 (2) Supply statistical data to the Department of Human Services, Mental
17 Health Services Division.

18 (3) Establish and maintain a sound financial management system in
19 accordance with guidelines as set forth by the Department of Human Services,
20 Mental Health Services Division.

21 (4) Establish and maintain community support programs designed to provide
22 coordinated care and treatment to ensure ongoing therapeutic involvement and
23 individualized treatment for persons with long-term, severe mental illness.
24 Every community support program shall use a coordinated case management
25 system and shall provide or assure access to services for persons with long-
26 term, severe mental illness who reside within the respective catchment area
27 of the Center. At a minimum, each community support program shall provide
28 assessment, diagnosis, identification of persons in need of services, case
29 management, crisis intervention, psychiatric treatment including medication
30 services and supervision, counseling and psychotherapy, activities of daily
31 living, housing, protection and advocacy, and psychosocial rehabilitation
32 which may include services provided by day treatment programs.

33 (5) The Board of Directors of each Center or Clinic licensed or certified
34 by the Department of Human Services, Mental Health Services Division, shall
35 adopt and submit to the Deputy Director, Mental Health Services Division, in
36 the form and according to the procedures specified by the Deputy Director,

1 Mental Health Services Division, an annual plan for the delivery of community
2 support services for persons with long-term, severe mental illness. Each
3 Center's plan must be approved by the Deputy Director, Mental Health Services
4 Division.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
6 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

7
8 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MENTAL
10 HEALTH SERVICES - FEDERAL FUNDS. It is the specific intent of the General
11 Assembly that in the event of the availability of federal funding for the
12 Division of Mental Health Services during either year of the biennial period
13 ending ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005, that such funding be utilized to conserve
14 or reduce the expenditure of general revenue except where prohibited by law.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
16 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

17
18 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MENTAL
20 HEALTH SERVICES. Pay rates for physicians and chief psychologists within the
21 Division of Mental Health Services may include the special allowances
22 available to UAMS physicians and professional faculty as described in the
23 special language of the UAMS appropriation. Part of the salaries of such
24 staff will come from the receipt of professional income in the care of
25 patients and/or funds received from federal agencies, foundations and other
26 private sponsors in the support of research. Provided that any such
27 allowance shall not exceed, for any employee, an amount equal to two and one
28 half times the salary authorized by the General assembly. The specific
29 Division of Mental Health classifications covered by this language are:

 5 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

6
 7 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MENTAL
 9 HEALTH SERVICES - VOCATIONAL TRAINEES. The Division of Mental Health
 10 Services of the Department of Human Services is hereby authorized during the
 11 ~~2001-2003~~ 2003-2005 biennium to provide employment opportunities for some of
 12 the working residents who are separate from the currently authorized regular
 13 vocational trainee positions. The positions authorized herein shall not be
 14 incorporated into the present classification system but shall be provided for
 15 by each Community Mental Health Center, or State Hospital, on a cash account
 16 basis. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the authorization of
 17 these positions shall facilitate the Agency's ability to provide for
 18 residents who are not part of a regular vocational training program.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
 20 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

 22 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MENTAL
 24 HEALTH SERVICES - JOB SHARE. The Division of Mental Health Services can
 25 utilize job share for positions within the nursing classification
 26 (RN, LPN/LPTN, MHW/CNA) for up to 24 hours per week per individual. This will
 27 allow the Division to offer weekend option shifts to nursing personnel
 28 without increasing the number of positions.

29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
 30 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

31
 32 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MENTAL
 34 HEALTH SERVICES - STATE HOSPITAL CONTINGENCY POSITIONS. If the Department of
 35 Human Services determines, and after prior review by the Legislative Council,
 36 it shall be determined that it is in the best interest of the State of

1 Arkansas to discontinue a management contract with a private provider and it
 2 is deemed necessary to utilize Department staff to provide the required
 3 services, the Director of the Department of Human Services may request the
 4 Department of Finance and Administration to approve the establishment of one
 5 or more additional positions at salary rates not to exceed the maximum
 6 salaries established for comparable positions in the Uniform Classification
 7 and Compensation Act, the Department of Human Services' Appropriation Act,
 8 and the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences' Appropriation Act. Upon
 9 approval by the Department of Finance and Administration and after review by
 10 the Legislative Council, the Department of Human Services, Division of Mental
 11 Health Services may establish such positions.

12 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
 13 established herein during the next biennium, the position(s) must be
 14 requested as a new position(s) in the agencies biennial budget request.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~ July
 16 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

17
 18 SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 19 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 20 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 21 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

27
 28 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 29 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 30 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 31 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 32 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 33 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 34 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 35 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

36

1 SECTION 23. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
3 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
4 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
5 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
7 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
8 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
9 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
10 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
11 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
