30	6-20-2003. Limits on funding.		
31	(a) Beginning in school year 2004-2005, public school districts shall		
32	be limited to using the following amounts of state funds for athletic		
33	<pre>expenditures:</pre>		
34	(1) For interschool athletic programs offered to students in		
35	grades six through eight (6-8), a school district shall not spend from state		
36	funds more than:		

1	(A) A flat base of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000); plus
2	(B) Sixty dollars (\$60.00) per student for each student in
3	grades six through eight (6-8) exceeding five hundred (500) students per the
4	district's third quarter average daily membership for the previous school
5	year; and
6	(2) For interschool athletic programs offered to students in
7	grades nine through twelve (9-12), a school district shall not spend from
8	state funds more than:
9	(A) A flat base of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), plus
10	(B) One hundred twenty dollars (\$120) per student for each
11	student in grades nine through twelve (9-12) exceeding five hundred (500)
12	students per the district's third quarter average daily membership for the
13	previous school year.
14	(b) School districts shall allocate funds to provide gender equity in
15	interschool athletic programs.

17	6-20-2004. Certification by local district school board.
18	(a) Annually by September 15 of each year, the local school board of
19	directors of each school district shall:
20	(1) Certify to the State Board of Education that:
21	(A) For the previous school year, excluding the 2003-2004
22	school year, the district's total athletic expenditures for interschool
23	athletic programs did not exceed:
24	(i) The allowable state funds as set out in § 6-20-
25	2003; plus
26	(ii) Other sources of funding that are not state
27	funds including, but no limited to, ticket sales, donations, fundraisers, or
28	local funds in excess of the uniform rate of ad valorem property tax under
29	Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 74; and
30	(B) For the upcoming school year, the district's total
31	athletic expenditures for interschool athletic programs will not exceed:
32	(i) The allowable state support as set out in § 6-

34	(ii) Other budgeted sources of funding that are not
35	state funds including, but no limited to, ticket sales, donations,
36	fundraisers, or local funds in excess of the uniform rate of ad valorem

3	district's total athletic expenditures in a format approved by the state
4	board or the Department of Education for the previous school year and post
5	the report on the school district's website;

8	upcoming year and post the report on the school district's website; and
9	(4) Provide the state board and the department with any
10	additional information or documentation requested.
11	(b)(1) Any school district failing to comply with the provisions of
12	this subchapter and the rules adopted for the implementation of this
13	subchapter shall be identified by the department to be a school in fiscal
14	distress in accordance with the Arkansas Fiscal Assessment and Accountability
15	Program, § 6-20-1901 et seq.
16	(2) Any report required by this subchapter shall be subject to a
17	yearly audit which shall be filed as set forth under $\S\S 6-20-1801-6-20-$

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20	6-20-2005. Regulations — Nondiscriminatory application.
21	(a)(1) By May 1, 2004, the State Board of Education shall promulgate
22	any rules necessary for the implementation of this subchapter.
23	(2) The rules shall include a procedure to be developed by the
24	Department of Education to ensure uniform reporting of athletic expenditures.
25	(b) The provisions of this subchapter shall be implemented as
26	necessary to provide gender equity in interschool athletic programs
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
