1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 2 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 8 9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 20 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the Arkansas 21 Supreme Court has ruled the current system of education in Arkansas is 22 inadequate and inequitable and has included as a basic component additional 23 support for teacher recruitment is necessary; that the Department of 24 Education through the Arkansas Teacher Housing Development Foundation needs 25 financial assistance to provide housing incentives to attract high-performing 26 teachers to "high-priority school districts"; that the effectiveness of this 27 Act on the date of its passage and approval is essential to the operation of 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that 29 the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its passage 30 and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is 31 32 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate 33 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 34 35 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
