32	SECTION 2. COMPLIANC	CE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of	funds authoriz	ed

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Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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6 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 8 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 10 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 13 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 14

- 15 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 16 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 17 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that due to the Arkansas Supreme Court decision in the Lake View School District No. 25 v. 18 Huckabee, et al, the effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and 19 20 approval is essential to the operation of the agency for which the 21 appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an 22 extension of the Second Extraordinary Session, the delay in the effective 23 date of this Act beyond the date of its passage and approval could work 24 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist 25 26 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 27 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the 28 date of its passage and approval. 29 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 30 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 31 32 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 33 the veto. 34 35
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
