26	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - SUPPLEMENTAL MILLAGE INCENTIVE FUNDING. There

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 3 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 9 10 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 19 20 Assembly, that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2004 is essential to 21 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are 22 provided due to the November 2002 Arkansas Supreme Court decision regarding 23 Arkansas Public Schools, and that in the event of an extension of the Second 24 Extraordinary Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond 25 July 1, 2004 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and 26 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is 27 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate 28 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force 29 and effect from and after July 1, 2004. 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
