## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO CREATE THE FEDERAL FISCAL RELIEF FUND;  
10 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
11

## Subtitle

12 AN ACT TO CREATE THE FEDERAL FISCAL  
13 RELIEF FUND.  
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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 12 is  
20 amended by adding the following new section concerning the establishment of  
21 miscellaneous funds to read as follows:

22 19-5-1221. Federal Fiscal Relief Fund.

23 (a) There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
24 the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be  
25 known as the Federal Fiscal Relief Fund.

26 (b)(1)(A) This fund shall consist of those monies remaining in the  
27 State Treasury received from the Jobs and Growth Tax Relief Reconciliation  
28 Act of 2003, Public Law 108-27 which have not been transferred to other funds  
29 prior to the effective date of this act.

30 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Treasurer  
31 of State shall transfer those monies as set out in subdivision (A) of this  
32 subsection, from the funds in which they reside to the Federal Fiscal Relief  
33 Fund.

34 (2) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall, from time to  
35 time, determine any balances of the monies transferred from the Jobs and  
36 Growth Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2003, Public Law 108-27 to other



1 funds due to enactments of the Eighty-Fourth General Assembly meeting in  
 2 Second Extraordinary Session which are no longer required to fulfill the  
 3 purpose for which the funds were transferred and shall transfer those  
 4 balances to the fund.

5 (3) (A) An amount of not to exceed twenty two million seven  
 6 hundred twenty seven thousand three hundred eighty four dollars (\$22,727,384)  
 7 in the fund may be used to supplement general revenues if required to meet  
 8 the current forecast of general revenues which is in effect at the time of  
 9 the passage of this Act.

10 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may transfer the  
 11 amount required to supplement general revenues from the fund to the General  
 12 Revenue Fund Account after review by the Legislative Council or the Joint  
 13 Budget Committee.

14 (C) Any remaining monies in the fund shall be used for  
 15 those purposes as may be authorized by the General Assembly.

16 (c) Any enactment of the Eighty-Fourth General Assembly meeting in  
 17 Second Extraordinary Session which requires a transfer from monies received  
 18 from the Jobs and Growth Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2003, Public Law  
 19 108-27, shall be deemed to be from the Federal Fiscal Relief Fund as  
 20 established herein.

 22 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
 23 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that monies received through the  
 24 provisions of the Jobs and Growth Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2003,  
 25 Public Law 108-27 should be transferred to a fund in the State Treasury  
 26 created by law; that the provisions of this Act create a fund as determined  
 27 by the General Assembly; and that this act is immediately necessary because  
 28 these monies are vitally needed in order to fund various provisions of law  
 29 enacted to meet requirements of the Supreme Court decision in Lake View  
 30 School District No. 25 v. Huckabee, 351 Ark. 31 (2002). Therefore, an  
 31 emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for  
 32 the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become  
 33 effective on:

34 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

35 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,  
 36 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the

1 bill; or

2 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
3 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.

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
