## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE KNOWLEDGE  
10 BASE SYSTEM FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE WHICH  
11 SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE  
12 FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1314 OF 2003; AND FOR  
13 OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE -

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - KNOWLEDGE BASE SYSTEM. There is hereby  
25 appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the State Central  
26 Services Fund, for costs associated with the operations of the Knowledge Base  
27 System of the Secretary of State which shall be supplemental and in addition  
28 to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 1314 of 2003, the following:

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34 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
35 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
36 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the



1 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7  
 8 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 14 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16  
 17 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 18 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of  
 19 the Secretary of State are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for  
 20 the Secretary of State to continue to provide essential governmental  
 21 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies  
 22 for the Secretary of State to continue such services; and that a delay in the  
 23 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
 24 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,  
 25 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
 26 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in  
 27 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

28 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
 29 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
 30 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
 31 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides  
 32 the veto.
