17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-18-208 is amended to add an additional*
20 *subsection to read as follows:*

21 *(d)(1) No school or school district shall:*

22 *(A) Use, display, release, or print a student's social*
23 *security number or any part of the number on any report, identification card,*
24 *identification badge, or any document that will be made available or released*
25 *to the public, a student, or a student's parent or guardian without the*
26 *express written consent of the student's parent, if the student is a minor,*
27 *or the student, if the student is eighteen (18) years of age or older; or*

28 *(B) Make a student's social security number available by*
29 *reading the magnetic strip or other encoded information on the student's*
30 *identification card.*

31 *(2) This section shall not apply to educational records that are*
32 *transferred to or between the Department of Education, other public schools*
33 *or school districts, or other governmental agencies as allowed or required by*
34 *federal law, state law, or State Board of Education rule.*
