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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
24 Crime Information Center for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum
25 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
33 or its successor.

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18 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF
20 CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION AND FUNDING. To the extent federal funding is not
21 available to the Arkansas Crime Information Center during the 2005-2007
22 biennium for the Computerized Criminal History Program or the JusticeXchange
23 Program, the Contingency Appropriation authorized herein may be used for
24 regular salaries, personal services matching and maintenance and general
25 operation line item appropriations authorized for such programs in this Act.
26 Funding for the Contingency Appropriation authorized herein may be
27 transferred to the appropriate fund or fund account from such excess funds as
28 the Director of the Arkansas Crime Information Center may determine are
29 available from criminal background check fees deposited on behalf of the
30 Arkansas Crime Information Center. Use of the contingency appropriation and
31 funding authorized in this Act shall be approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer
32 of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

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34 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
36 FORWARD. At the close of each fiscal year, the Director of the Arkansas

1 Crime Information Center shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
2 State the amount, if any, of unexpended monies and appropriation in the Crime
3 Information Center Fund, or its successor, resulting from the reimbursement
4 to the Arkansas Crime Information Center by municipal, county, state or
5 federal governments for teleprocessing services. Any balance of such monies
6 and appropriation shall be carried forward and made available for the
7 maintenance, operation, improvement and other necessary expenditures in
8 providing teleprocessing services to such municipal, county, state, and
9 federal agencies served by the Arkansas Crime Information Center. The total
10 amount which is carried forward under the provisions of this section shall be
11 reported in the Budget Manuals which are presented to the Arkansas
12 Legislative Council/Joint Budget Committee during the pre-session budget
13 hearings which are held in the fall of each even numbered year.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
15 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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17 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
18 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
19 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
20 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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27 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
30 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
32 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
33 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
34 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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36 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

1 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
2 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
3 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
6 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
7 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
8 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
9 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
10 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
