19 BIENNIUM.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
26 Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services for the
27 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
28 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification
29 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor,
30 and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to
31 which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be
32 exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation
33 Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed
34 by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act
35 (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: eighteen (18) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - MEALS ON WHEELS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services,

1 to be payable from the Aging and Adult Services Fund Account, for the Meals
 2 on Wheels Program and transportation services for the elderly of the
 3 Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services for the
 4 biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

 14 of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services for the biennial
 15 period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

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SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SENIOR OLYMPICS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services, to be payable from the Aging and Adult Services Fund Account, for matching funds for the Arkansas Senior Olympics of the Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - BLUE AND YOU GRANT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for grants and aid by the Blue and You Foundation of the Department of Human Services - Division of Aging and Adult Services for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND ADULT SERVICES - CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of funds and appropriation authorized ~~in Section 3~~ for elderly transportation including the Meals on Wheels Program which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2003~~ 2005 or June 30, ~~2004~~ 2006 or both, shall be carried forward into the next fiscal year, there to be used for the same purpose.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND

1 ADULT SERVICES - MATCHING FUNDS. The funds appropriated for state match for
 2 the Arkansas Senior Olympics Program in this Act shall be paid on a two-to-
 3 one state/local matching basis. The Senior Arkansas Sports Organization must
 4 certify its portion of the match to the Division of Aging and Adult Services
 5 before any funds appropriated for state match for the Arkansas Senior
 6 Olympics Program in this Act are disbursed.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
 8 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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10 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND
 12 ADULT SERVICES - STATE MATCH AUTHORIZED. The Director of the Department of
 13 Human Services is authorized to use State funds appropriated in this Act to
 14 match Federal funds available under Title III and Title V of the Older
 15 Americans Act, Social Services Block Grant, or such other federal funds as
 16 may become available.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
 18 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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20 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND
 22 ADULT SERVICES - GRANT/CONTRACT DISBURSEMENT GUIDELINES. All appropriations
 23 for state and federal funding contained herein for the Division of Aging and
 24 Adult Services and that are distributed under grant or contract methodologies
 25 may be disbursed by the Department of Human Services in the same manner as
 26 authorized under federal regulations for the disbursement of Title III Older
 27 Americans Act funds. Otherwise, all disbursements shall comply with the
 28 provisions of this Act.

29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
 30 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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32 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND
 34 ADULT SERVICES - NURSING HOME CARE ALTERNATIVES. Funding for "Nursing Home
 35 Care Alternatives", as it appears in the Aging and Adult Services -
 36 Operations appropriation may be used for home delivered meals, adult day

1 care, homemaker/chore, respite care, personal care, health promotion, and
 2 other community based activities. These funds may also be used to match
 3 Medicaid community based programs.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
 5 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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 7 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 8 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 9 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 10 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 17 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 18 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 19 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 20 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 21 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 22 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 23 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 24 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 26 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 28 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
 29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 31 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 32 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
 33 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 34 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 35 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 36 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.

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
