## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE WAR  
11 MEMORIAL STADIUM COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR  
12 ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE WAR MEMORIAL STADIUM  
16 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE FISCAL  
17 YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2005.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to  
24 the War Memorial Stadium Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous  
25 Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
26 War Memorial Stadium Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, the  
27 following:

7 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
9 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal  
10 Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the  
11 State Treasurer and Auditor of the State the sum of six hundred thousand  
12 dollars (\$600,000) from the Federal Fiscal Relief Fund to the Miscellaneous  
13 Agencies Fund Account to provide funds for the Operations appropriation  
14 authorized in this Act.

15

16 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
17 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
18 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
19 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

26 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
27 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
28 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
29 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
30 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
31 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
32 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
33 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

35 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
36 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

1 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
2 effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is  
3 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this  
4 Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular  
5 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its  
6 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
7 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,  
8 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
9 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in  
10 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

11 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
12 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
13 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
14 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides  
15 the veto.
