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16 AN ACT FOR THE SAU-TECH - ENVIRONMENTAL
17 CONTROL CENTER - STATEWIDE SOLID WASTE
18 PROGRAM APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2005-2007
19 BIENNIUM.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL CENTER - STATEWIDE
26 SOLID WASTE PROGRAM. There is hereby established for the SAU-Tech -
27 Environmental Control Center - Statewide Solid Waste Program for the 2005-
28 2007 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
29 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification
30 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor,
31 and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to
32 which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be
33 exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation
34 Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed
35 by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act
36 (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL CENTER - STATEWIDE SOLID WASTE PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to the SAU-Tech, to be payable from the SAU-Tech Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the SAU-Tech - Environmental Control Center - Statewide Solid Waste Program for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
2 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
3 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
4 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
5 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
6 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
7 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
8 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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10 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
11 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
12 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
13 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
14 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
16 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
17 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
18 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
19 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
20 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.

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
