19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-17-108(c), pertaining to the salary of
22 the Ashdown District Court Judge, is amended to read as follows:

23 (c) The Ashdown District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of
24 not less than thirty-two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$32,800) nor more
25 than forty-four thousand dollars (\$44,000), as determined by the governing
26 body of the City of Ashdown and the Quorum Court of Little River County. ~~The~~
27 ~~salary shall be paid sixty two percent (62%) by Little River County and~~
28 ~~thirty eight percent (38%) by the City of Ashdown, unless otherwise agreed by~~
29 ~~the Quorum Court of Little River County and the governing body of the City of~~
30 ~~Ashdown.~~ The salary shall be apportioned by ordinance adopted by the Quorum
31 Court of Little River County. The salary shall be apportioned among and paid
32 to the county from the respective cities of the first class and cities of the
33 second class, incorporated towns, and the Quorum Court of Little River County
34 as a prorated amount based on the number of cases filed from each of the
35 towns and cities and the county during the preceding calendar year.
