16 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the President of Arkansas 18 19 State University that a reallocation of resources for purposes of 20 reorganization or consolidation of administrative functions within the 21 university is necessary for efficient and effective operations of the 22 university, the president, with approval of the Arkansas State University 23 Board of Trustees, may have the authority to transfer positions, 24 appropriations and related funds between campuses, divisions, branches, and 25 other budgetary units of Arkansas State University. The transfers of 26 positions, programs, or activities shall be used for those purposes for which 27 the appropriations were approved by the General Assembly. The transfers, 28 consolidation, or reorganization which involve academic programs shall be 29 reviewed by the Department of Higher Education and receive prior approval 30 from the Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee. 31 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 32 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 33 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by

34 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

35 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by

36 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly

1 has determined that Arkansas State University may operate more efficiently if 2 some flexibility is provided to Arkansas State University authorizing broad 3 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate 4 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of 5 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this 6 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 7 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement 8 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled 9 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 10 void. 11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 12 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 13 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 14 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LEASES. 16 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the Board of Trustees of Arkansas 17 State University may hereafter lease facilities for operations for room and 18 board purposes in any manner and upon terms the board deems to be in the best 19 interest of the university. Action taken under this act shall be by written 20 resolution adopted by at least a majority of the members of the board. 21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 22 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 23 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 26 CONTINGENCY. (a) To address needs emerging from the restructuring of the 27 Technical Institutes, ASU Technical Center shall establish and maintain for 28 the 2003-2005 2005-2007 biennium a pool of four (4) unclassified positions 29 and three (3) classified positions, payable from funds appropriated for ASU 30 Technical Center. These positions are to be used by ASU Technical Center in the event that the number and level of positions available to address the 31 32 needs emerging from business and industry driven program expansions exceeds

33 the number of positions regularly authorized for ASU Technical Center.
34 (b) ASU Technical Center shall provide justification to the Department of
35 Finance and Administration's Office of Personnel Management (OPM) for the
36 need to allocate titles from this position pool. No classifications will be

1 assigned to the pool until such time as specific positions are requested and 2 justified by ASU Technical Center, recommended by OPM and approved by the Legislative Council. ASU Technical Center may transfer positions from this 3 4 pool to any pay schedule the agency currently maintains or any pay schedule 5 the agency receives during the 2003-2005 2005-2007 biennium. 6 (c) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is 7 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by 8 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the 9 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has 10 determined that ASU Technical Center could be operated more efficiently if 11 some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is being 12 accomplished by providing growth pools in subsection (a) of this section and 13 since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers under the 14 growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General 15 Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by 16 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the 17 growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative 18 Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of 19 approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court of 20 competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 21 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as

established herein during the next biennium, the position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in the agencies biennial budget request. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 29 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 30 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 31 32 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 33 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 34 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 35 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 36 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the

President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon
 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal
 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board
 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.
 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

8 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 13 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 14 15 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 16 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 17 with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of 31 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 34 35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 36
