- 34 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. Arkansas
- 36 Code 13-6-205 is amended to read as follows:

- 1 (c) The Arkansas Archeological Survey is authorized to enter into contracts 2 with and to receive and expend gifts, grants, or other funds from federal, 3 private, or other sources to be used in furtherance of the program of the 4 Survey within the limitations of the maximum annual salary rates as set forth 5 by law. 6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 7 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 8 9 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE AND 10 11 DISBURSING OFFICER. The funds appropriated under Section 3 and allocated in 12 Item (5) of Section 4 of this Act are to be used for the personal services and maintenance and general operation of the Arkansas Archeological Survey 13 14 and for no other purpose. The Vice-President for Finance and Administration 15 of the University of Arkansas is hereby made the disbursing officer for the 16 appropriation made by this Act. 17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 18 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 19 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 20 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 22 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing 23 and other unusual expenses incurred by or on behalf of the athletic 24 directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches, 25 assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head 26 trainers in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at the University of 27 Arkansas, Fayetteville, the Board of Trustees may make special allowances available therefor in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may determine as 28 29 justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and exacting duties 30 of said athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head 31 coaches, assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, 32 and head trainers in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at the
- income of the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, which is derived from

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University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, and for the purpose of providing such

allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary

1 funds, an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each for such 2 purposes during each year of the 2003-2005 2005-2007 biennium for the 3 athletic directors, associate athletic directors, and head coaches, and an 4 amount not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) each for the assistant 5 athletic directors, assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive 6 coordinators, and head trainers. Any such allowances shall be in addition to 7 the regular salary of such athletic directors, associate and assistant 8 athletic directors, head coaches and assistant coaches. Further, if the 9 special allowance funds authorized herein are utilized the University of 10 Arkansas, Fayetteville shall report annually to the Arkansas Legislative 11 Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of those special allowance 12 funds. In recognition of the extra work involved in the participation of intercollegiate athletic teams in post-season competition, and to promote 13 14 exceptional achievement in the total sports program, the Chancellor of the 15 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, in accordance with policies issued by 16 the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas, may approve additional 17 compensation of up to one month's salary for the Athletic Department and Band 18 personnel when any athletic team participates in post-season competition or 19 achieves exceptional recognition, which shall be in addition to the regular 20 salaries authorized by law, provided that the additional compensation shall 21 be paid from contributions from sources other than public funds. 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 23 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 24 25 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 27 ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS AUTHORIZED. The Board of Trustees of the University of 28 Arkansas is hereby authorized to make additional payments to head coaches at

29 the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, from revenues generated by 30 contracts with vendors of athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such 31 amounts as may be established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the 32 coaches of consulting and other obligations pursuant to contracts between the 33 University and such vendors. Such additional payments to head coaches shall 34 not be considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the 35 maximum salaries established for such coaches by the General Assembly. 36 Nothing in this section shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the

1 authority granted elsewhere in Arkansas statutes for the payment of 2 allowances or bonuses to coaches at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville. 3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 4 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 5 6 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 8 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 9 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 10 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 11 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 12 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 13 14 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 15 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the 16 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon 17 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal 18 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board 19 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 20 21 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 22 23 SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 24 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 25 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 26 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 29 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 30 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 31 32 with in disbursement of said funds. 33 34 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 35 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 36 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

1	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
2	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
3	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
4	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
5	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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7	SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
9	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
10	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
11	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
14	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
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
