6 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 8 PROVISION. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act the Chief Fiscal 9 Officer of the State, Treasurer of State and Auditor of State shall transfer 10 on their books the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) Five 11 Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$530,000) from the Special State Assets 12 Forfeiture Fund to the University of Arkansas Fund for allocation to the 13 Criminal Justice Institute. Of the total monies transferred by this section, One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) Two Hundred Thirty Thousand 14 15 Dollars (\$230,000) shall be allocated each fiscal year of the 2005-2007 16 biennium and made available to the Criminal Justice Institute for the 2003-04 17 fiscal year for expenses associated with delivering computer training to law 18 enforcement officers statewide and for providing computer equipment to rural 19 law enforcement agencies, the Criminal Justice Institute and computer labs. 20 Of the remaining Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) transferred, One 21 hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) shall be allocated each fiscal 22 year of the 2003-05 biennium to the Criminal Justice Institute for expenses 23 associated with delivering courses to assist law enforcement in safely 24 responding to education and training to assist the criminal justice community 25 in addressing the clandestine methamphetamine activities in the State and to 26 design and deliver a program to assist DEA certified officers in the State 27 meet yearly certification requirements. 28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 29 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

30

31 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO 33 EXPENDITURES. Proceeds derived from the maturity or redemptions of 34 investments as authorized in Section 6 of this Act for the University of 35 Arkansas Soils Testing and Research Program shall be deemed "Refunds to 36 Expenditures" for all monies invested.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. Arkansas
Code 13-6-205 is amended to read as follows:

7 (c) The Arkansas Archeological Survey is authorized to enter into contracts 8 with and to receive and expend gifts, grants, or other funds from federal, 9 private, or other sources to be used in furtherance of the program of the 10 Survey within the limitations of the maximum annual salary rates as set forth 11 by law.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2003}{2005}$  through June 30,  $\frac{2005}{2007}$ .

15 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE AND 17 DISBURSING OFFICER. The funds appropriated under Section 3 and allocated in Item (5) of Section 4 of this Act are to be used for the personal services 18 19 and maintenance and general operation of the Arkansas Archeological Survey and for no other purpose. The Vice-President for Finance and Administration 20 21 of the University of Arkansas is hereby made the disbursing officer for the 22 appropriation made by this Act.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
24 <u>2005</u> through June 30, 2005 <u>2007</u>.

26 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 28 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing 29 and other unusual expenses incurred by or on behalf of the athletic 30 directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches, assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head 31 32 trainers in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at the University of 33 Arkansas, Fayetteville, the Board of Trustees may make special allowances 34 available therefor in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and exacting duties 35 36 of said athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head

1 coaches, assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, 2 and head trainers in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, and for the purpose of providing such 3 4 allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary 5 income of the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, which is derived from 6 athletic event receipts, or from contributions from sources other than state 7 funds, an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each for such 8 purposes during each year of the 2003-2005 2005-2007 biennium for the 9 athletic directors, associate athletic directors, and head coaches, and an 10 amount not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) each for the assistant 11 athletic directors, assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive 12 coordinators, and head trainers. Any such allowances shall be in addition to the regular salary of such athletic directors, associate and assistant 13 14 athletic directors, head coaches and assistant coaches. Further, if the 15 special allowance funds authorized herein are utilized the University of 16 Arkansas, Fayetteville shall report annually to the Arkansas Legislative 17 Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of those special allowance 18 funds. In recognition of the extra work involved in the participation of 19 intercollegiate athletic teams in post-season competition, and to promote exceptional achievement in the total sports program, the Chancellor of the 20 21 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, in accordance with policies issued by 22 the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas, may approve additional 23 compensation of up to one month's salary for the Athletic Department and Band 24 personnel when any athletic team participates in post-season competition or 25 achieves exceptional recognition, which shall be in addition to the regular 26 salaries authorized by law, provided that the additional compensation shall 27 be paid from contributions from sources other than public funds.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2003}{2005}$  through June 30,  $\frac{2005}{2007}$ .

31 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 33 ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS AUTHORIZED. The Board of Trustees of the University of 34 Arkansas is hereby authorized to make additional payments to head coaches at 35 the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, from revenues generated by 36 contracts with vendors of athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such

1 amounts as may be established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the 2 coaches of consulting and other obligations pursuant to contracts between the University and such vendors. Such additional payments to head coaches shall 3 4 not be considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the 5 maximum salaries established for such coaches by the General Assembly. 6 Nothing in this section shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the 7 authority granted elsewhere in Arkansas statutes for the payment of 8 allowances or bonuses to coaches at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville. 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 10 2005 through June 30, <del>2005</del> 2007.

SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 12 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER SCHOOL 13 14 EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular school 15 term also work during the summer months, shall be authorized as additional 16 compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary for each 17 month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. 18 19 Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees in the following classifications: 20

30 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 31 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHER GRANT 32 RELATED FUNDING PROVISION. Teachers of the School for Mathematics and 33 Sciences who, in addition to fulfilling annual teaching contract requirements 34 also write grants, grant progress reports and write and publish papers may be 35 authorized as additional annual compensation an amount up to 1/12 of their 36 annual salary. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as

exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. The additional
 compensation authorized by this section shall only be paid from a portion of
 the grant monies received and shall not be paid from state general revenues
 or Educational Excellence Trust Fund monies.

5 <u>The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005</u>
6 <u>through June 30, 2007.</u>

7

8 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 9 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 10 11 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 12 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 13 14 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 15 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 16 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 17 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon 18 19 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board 20 21 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year. 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 23 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

24

SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 25 26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 31 32 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 33 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 34 with in disbursement of said funds.

36 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
3	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
7	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
8	
9	SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
11	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
12	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
13	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
14	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
15	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
16	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
17	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
18	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
19	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
