21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-125-109(d), concerning payments made to
24 soil and water conservation districts from the Arkansas Soil and Water
25 Commission, is amended to read as follows:

26 (d) The Division of Legislative Audit ~~shall~~ may annually audit the
27 books and accounts of each of the soil conservation districts receiving
28 payments under the provisions of this section. All payments made to such
29 districts shall be used for the purposes provided for in this section. Any
30 soil conservation district which shall violate the provisions of this section
31 shall not thereafter for a period of three (3) years be eligible for payments
32 under the provisions of this section. Any member of the board of directors of
33 any soil conservation district or any other person or persons who shall
34 violate any of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a
35 misdemeanor.
