15 SECTION 31. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 16 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 17 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is 18 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this 19 20 Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular 21 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its 22 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper 23 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, 24 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the 25 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in 26 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 27 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 28 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 29 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 30 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 31 the veto. 32 33 34 35 36
