BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Title 10, Chapter 2, Subchapter 1 of the Arkansas Code is
26 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

27 10-2-130. Use of education studies commissioned by the General
28 Assembly.

29 (a)(1) Any cost study analysis, cost study audit, adequacy study, or
30 other study commissioned or funded by the General Assembly concerning the
31 state's education system and any conclusion or recommendations resulting from
32 a cost study analysis, cost study audit, adequacy study, or other study
33 concerning the state's education system shall not be binding upon the General
34 Assembly.

35 (2) The General Assembly may reject at any time any analysis,
36 audit, or study and any conclusions or recommendations resulting from an



1 analysis, audit, or study concerning the state's education system.
2 (b) A cost study analysis, cost study audit, adequacy study, or other
3 study concerning the state's education system shall include, but is not
4 limited to:
5 (1) Studies conducted under § 10-3-2101 et seq. and Act 1181 of
6 2003; and
7 (2) Any study concerning the adequacy or equitability of the
8 state's education system, including, but not limited to, the state's method
9 of funding public school districts.
