24	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the			
25	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Supreme Court			
26	found that the public school funding system continues to be inadequate and			
27	the public schools are operating under a constitutional infirmity which must			
28	be corrected immediately; that to correct the constitutional infirmity and to			
29	provide adequate funding for public education, the amount of funding provide			
30	to school districts shall be revised; and that this act is necessary to allow			
31	the Department of Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State			
32	sufficient time to make all necessary adjustments, calculations, and			
33	distributions. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act			
34	being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety			
35	shall become effective on:			
36	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;			

1	(2) If the bill is heither approved nor veloed by the Governor,
2	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
3	bill; or
4	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
5	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
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
