1 (B)(3) Effective July 1, 2007, The the Division of Public 2 School Accountability, established under § 6-15-102, shall be under the 3 department. 4 (b)(1) The Division of Public School Accountability and the Division 5 of Research and Technology shall have such duties as provided by law. 6 (2) The Division of Public School Academic Facilities and 7 Transportation shall have duties as provided by law and such responsibility 8 and programs as may be assigned by the Commission for Arkansas Public School 9 Academic Facilities and Transportation. (2)(3) The remaining divisions shall have such responsibility 10 11 and programs as may be assigned to them by the Commissioner of Education. 12 (c)(1) Each Except as provided in subdivision (c)(2) of this section, each division of the department shall be under the direction, control, and 13 14 supervision of the commissioner. 15 (2) The Division of Public School Academic Facilities and 16 Transportation shall be under the direction, control, and supervision of the 17 Commission for Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation. 18 19 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-21-114 is amended to read as follows: 6-21-114. Commission for Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities 20 21 and Transportation - Created. 22 (a) There is created the Commission for Arkansas Public School 23 Academic Facilities and Transportation. The commission shall consist of the 24 following: 25 (1)The Director of the Department of Finance and 26 Administration; 27 (2) The Commissioner of Education; and 28 (3) The President of the Arkansas Development Finance Authority. 29 (b)(1) The members of the commission shall meet and organize 30 immediately after March 29, 2005. The Commissioner of Education shall be the chair of the commission. 31 32 (2)(A) The commission shall meet at least quarterly and upon the 33 call of the chair. 34 (B)(i) The secretary of the commission shall be an 35 employee of the Division of Public School Academic Facilities and 36 Transportation assigned to the commission by the chair of the commission.

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1 (ii) The secretary shall give members advance notice 2 of the agenda of each meeting. (d) 12 (e) The commission may: 13 (1) Perform any act and provide for the performance of any 14 function necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes of the Arkansas 15 Public School Academic Facilities Program and any other related program; 16 (2)(A) Adopt, amend, and rescind rules as necessary or desirable 17 for the administration of the Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities 18 Program and any other related program-; and (B) No later than October 1, 2005, the commission shall 19 20 submit to the Legislative Council for review proposed rules necessary to 21 administer the Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities Program. 22 (C) The effective date of rules developed by the 23 commission to administer the Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities 24 Program shall be no later than December 1, 2005; and 25 (3) Contract with, retain the services of, or designate and fix 26 the compensation of consultants, advisors, architects, engineers, and other 27 independent contractors as may be necessary or desirable to carry out the 28 Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities Program or any related program. 29 (f) The commission shall report annually on its activities to the 30 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 31 Representatives, the Governor, the House Interim Committee on Education, the 32 Senate Interim Committee on Education, the State Board of Education, and the 33 Academic Facilities Oversight Committee. 34 (g)(1) Effective July 1, 2007, the commission shall expire, and all 35 powers, authorities, duties, and responsibilities of the commission with regard to oversight of the Division of Public School Academic Facilities and 36

It is found and determined by the 25 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Supreme Court 26 declared the public school funding system to be inadequate and that the 27 public schools are operating under a constitutional infirmity which must be 28 corrected immediately; that to correct the constitutional infirmity the 29 General Assembly must guarantee the provision of adequate academic 30 facilities; and that the continued existence of the Commission for Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation will assist the state in 31 32 its efforts to guarantee adequate academic facilities for students throughout 33 the state. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being 34 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall 35 become effective on: 36 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
