36	(a) Effective July 1,	2006, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the	e State shall	



1 transfer, from the unobligated balances in the General Improvement Fund to 2 the Department of Higher Education Fund Account the sum of five hundred 3 seventy thousand three hundred three dollars (\$570,303). The amount 4 transferred shall be made available by the Department of Higher Education 5 during the 2007 fiscal year to provide grants to institutions of higher 6 education for the Elementary Science Specialist Program authorized by the 7 85th General Assembly meeting in First Extraordinary Session. 8 (b) On July 1, 2006 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer 9 on his books and those of the State Treasurer and the State Auditor, from the 10 General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund from the first monies due to general 11 revenue received over and above the amount required of the Revenue Stabilization Law during the 2005-06 fiscal year as set out in Arkansas Code 12 19-5-402, an amount equal to the transfer authorized in item (a) of this 13 section or so much thereof as is available, to the General Improvement Fund. 14 15 16 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

17 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 18 19 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 20 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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26 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 27 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 28 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 29 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 30 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 31 32 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 33 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 34

35 <u>SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General</u>
36 <u>Assembly, that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2006 is essential to</u>

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1	the continued operation of the Elementary Science Specialist Program
2	administered by the Arkansas Department of Higher Education for which the
3	appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an
4	extension of the First Extraordinary Session, the delay in the effective date
5	of this Act beyond July 1, 2006 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
6	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
7	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
8	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
9	full force and effect from and after July 1, 2006.
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
