24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE G	ENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26	SECTION 1. Arka	nsas Code § 6-20-2305(b)(4)(C)(i), concerning public								
27	school funding for nat	ional school lunch students, is amended to read as								
28	follows:									
29	(C)(i) The State Board of Education shall establish by ru	le							
30	a list of approved pro	grams and purposes for which funds allocated under th	is							
31	subdivision (b)(4) may	be expended.								
32		(ii) Through June 30, 2007, the State Board of								
33	Education shall includ	e in the list as an approved purpose the use of funds								
34	by a school district t	o supplement salaries for classroom teachers if the								
35	school district meets	the minimum salary schedule in § 6-17-2403 without								
36	using funds provided u	nder subdivision (b)(4) of this section.								

1	(iii) School districts shall expend funds allocated
2	under this subdivision (b)(4) only on the $\frac{approved}{approved}$ programs or purposes \underline{on}
3	the State Board of Education's list of approved programs and purposes for
4	which funds allocated under this subdivision (b)(4) may be expended, which
5	shall include, but are not limited to:
6	(a) Classroom teachers, provided that the
7	school district meets the minimum salary schedule in § $6-17-2403$ without
8	using funds provided under subdivision (b)(4) of this section and that those
9	teachers are used for the purposes delineated in subdivision (b)(4) of this
10	section and as allowed through June 30, 2007 under subdivision (b)(4)(C)(ii)
11	to supplement salaries of classroom teachers;
12	(b) Before-school academic programs and after-
13	school academic programs, including transportation to and from the programs;
14	(c) Prekindergarten programs coordinated by
15	the Department of Health and Human Services;
16	(d) Tutors, teachers' aides, counselors,
17	social workers, nurses, and curriculum specialists;
18	(e) Parent education;
19	(f) Summer programs;
20	(g) Early intervention programs; and
21	(h) Materials, supplies, and equipment,
22	including technology used in approved programs or for approved purposes.

24	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
25	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Supreme Court
26	found that the public school funding system continues to be inadequate and
27	the public schools are operating under a constitutional infirmity which must
28	be corrected immediately; that to correct the constitutional infirmity and to
29	provide adequate funding for public education, the amount and use of funding
30	provided to school districts shall be revised; and that this act is necessary
31	to allow the Department of Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
32	State sufficient time to make all necessary adjustments, calculations, and
33	distributions. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act
34	being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety
35	shall become effective on:
36	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
