SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the War Memorial Stadium Commission for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred fifty (150) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the War Memorial Stadium Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services, operating expenses, major maintenance, renovation of facilities and scoreboards, and repairs of the War Memorial Stadium Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

2 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the function of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 3 4 delineating such maximums as the appropriation in the appropriation act(s) 5 for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each 6 fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. 7 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 8 maintain oversight be requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or 9 Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval be the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a 10 11 severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval be the 12 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the authority of the Commission to 13 14 acquire real estate is void. 15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 16 through June 30, 2009. 17 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 19 20 APPROPRIATION RESTRICTIONS - LOBBYISTS. The War Memorial Stadium Commission 21 shall not utilize any appropriation contained within this act for the purpose 22 of employing or compensating any person who is defined or designated as a 23 registered lobbyist under \$21-8-402(11) and \$21-8-601 et. seq., and as 24 recorded on the books of the Secretary of State. 25 26 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 27 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 28 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 29 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 31 32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 33 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 35 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 36

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of

1	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
3	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
7	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
8	
9	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
11	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
12	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
13	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
14	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
15	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
16	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
17	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
18	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
19	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
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
