21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State Athletic
24 Commission for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-
25 time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
26 appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time
27 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
28 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
29 for the appropriate classification.
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31 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
32 the State Athletic Commission, to be payable from the Arkansas Athletic
33 Commission Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the State
34 Athletic Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the

SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PER DIEM. Members shall be paid and receive a fee of no more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) per diem for each day in actual attendance at sporting events designated by the Board of the Athletic Commission for review. The per diem shall not apply to travel days to and from events. Commission members shall also be entitled to reimbursement as established by Act 1211 of 1995.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~ 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING PROVISIONS - BOYS AND GIRLS CLUBS. Three percent (3%) of the total gross receipts received by the State Athletic Commission from admission charges from matches, exhibitions and any other athletic event which the State Athletic Commission has jurisdiction over shall be used for Grants to the thirty-four (34) Boys and Girls Club Organizations within the State of Arkansas and one percent (1%) shall be used for Grants to the non-profit Amateur Boxing Clubs of the State of Arkansas who qualify. The State Athletic Commission shall distribute these Grants in equal amounts to all thirty-four (34) Boys and Girls Club Organizations, at the end of each six (6) month

1 period, provided there are sufficient funds to distribute a minimum of one
2 hundred dollars (\$100.00) to each entity, beginning upon the effective date
3 of this act and ending on June 30, 2009. Distribution of funds will be
4 contingent upon available appropriation and funding.

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6 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
7 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
8 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
9 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
12 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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16 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
18 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
23 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
27 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
30 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
32 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
33 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
34 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
35 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.

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
