Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized for Study Expenses in Item 4 of Section 19 of the Red River Levee Rehabilitation 14 15 Project section of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year 16 ending June 30, 2006 2008, shall be carried forward and made available for 17 the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007 2009. 18 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions: 19 20 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding 21 22 to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget; 23 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall 24 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from 25 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the 26 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 27 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which 28 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution 29 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the 30 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request 31 32 set forth in (1) above; 33 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written 34 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 35 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for 36

1 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 2 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 3 4 Committee; and 5 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include 6 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals 7 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or 8 Institution. 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 2007 10 through June 30, 2007 2009. 11 12 SECTION 36. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 13 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 14 15 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 18 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 21 22 SECTION 37. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 23 24 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 25 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 26 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 28 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 29 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 30 31 SECTION 38. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 32 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 33 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 34 35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 36

1	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
2	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
