1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 2 2007 through June 30, <del>2007</del> 2009. 3 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MEDICAL 6 SERVICES - CONTINGENCY POSITIONS. If it has been determined by the Board of 7 Corrections that the Department of Community Correction cannot continue a 8 medical contract with a private provider and the Board deems it necessary to 9 utilize Department staff to provide the required services, the Department is allowed, upon notification of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after 10 11 seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 12 Committee, to utilize the contingent positions for medical services contained in this Act and make the appropriate transfers from the Professional Fees and 13 14 Services line item contained in Section 3 of this Act to Regular Salaries, 15 Personal Services Matching and various Maintenance and General Operations 16 classifications. Further, the Department may utilize the service(s) of a 17 state-based or national-based Professional Recruitment Service, or network, 18 as may be necessary to recruit, fill, or maintain the occupancy of the 19 positions stated herein. 20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 21 2007 through June 30, <del>2007</del> 2009. 22 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 23 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REGULAR 25 SALARIES - CONTINGENT POSITIONS. There is hereby established for the 26 Department of Community Correction - Contingent Positions for the 2005-2007 27 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose 28 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification 29 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and 30 all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt 31 32 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All 33 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the 34 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas

20 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 22 COMMUNITY CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. The appropriations authorized under the line item established herein for "Community Correction Programs" 23 24 are to be used by the Department of Community Correction for establishment 25 and operation of, to include construction, renovation, and contracting for 26 establishment and operation of, residential and non-residential community

27 correction programs such as, but not limited to, community correction

28 centers, drug, alcohol, and mental health treatments, intensive supervision,

29 restitution, and others as established and approved by the Board of

30 Corrections and as may be provided by law.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 31 32 2007 through June 30, <del>2007</del> 2009.

SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 34 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a substantial 36

- 1 ten percent (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of
- 2 Community Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item in Section
- 3 State Operations to Operating Expense Item (05)(A) in Section 3 State
- 4 Operations for support of the increase after receiving approval of the Chief
- 5 Fiscal Officer of the State. Prior to the utilization of the transfer
- 6 <u>authority a report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint</u>
- 7 Budget Committee including justification for the transfer and the amount of
- 8 transfer.

- 9 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
- 10 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
- 11 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
- 12 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
- 13 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
- 14 <u>amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law.</u> Further, the General Assembly
- 15 <u>has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more</u>
- 16 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
- 17 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
- 18 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
- 19 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 20 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
- 21 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
- 22 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint

- 26 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
- 28 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Departments of Correction and Community
- 29 Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare and post
- 30 on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail
- 31 reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for
- 32 verification by the Departments and for payment from the County Jail
- 33 Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of
- 34 invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the
- 35 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end
- 36 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than

1	three (3) years.

3	SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
4	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
5	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
6	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
7	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
8	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
9	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
10	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
11	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
12	
13	SECTION $21$ . LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
14	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
15	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
16	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
17	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
18	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
19	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
20	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
21	
22	SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
23	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
24	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
25	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
26	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
27	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
28	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
29	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
30	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
31	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
32	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
