10 PROGRAM TO WARN MOTORISTS OF DANGEROUS AREAS OF
11 THE HIGHWAYS AND TO ALLOW THE FAMILY OR FRIENDS
12 OF A PERSON WHO HAS DIED AS A RESULT OF A MOTOR
13 VEHICLE ACCIDENT AT THAT LOCATION TO APPLY FOR A
14 MEMORIAL WITH THE NAME OF THE DECEASED TO BE
15 ADDED TO THE SIGN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 73, Subchapter 1 is amended
29 to add an additional section to read as follows:

30 27-73-103. Highway Memorial Safety Program.

31 (a) There is created the "Highway Memorial Safety Program", to be
32 administered by the State Highway Commission.

33 (b) The purpose of the program is to:

34 (1) Warn motorists of dangerous areas of the public highways by
35 placing signs on the right-of-way where a significant number of motor vehicle
36 accidents that resulted in deaths have occurred;



1 (2) Allow the family or friends of a person who has died as a
2 result of a motor vehicle accident at that location to apply for a memorial
3 with the name of the deceased to be added to the sign; and

4 (3) Reduce the number of motor vehicle accidents that result in
5 deaths on the public highways of this state.

6 (c)(1) The commission shall promulgate the rules necessary for the
7 implementation of the program.

8 (2) The rules shall include the procedure for making an
9 application for a memorial sign.

10 (d) This section shall be contingent on the appropriation and
11 availability of funding for the program.

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
