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SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code Annotated 6-62-104, concerning Transfer of appropriation, is repealed.

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Unless otherwise provided by law, each state-supported institution of higher education may transfer appropriations between the various line items within each appropriation contained in its biennial appropriation act. However, such transfers shall be made only after the approval of the Department of Higher Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and after seeking the advice of the Legislative Council.

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SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES FOR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION. Upon

determination by the president or chancellor of an institution of higher

education that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or

consolidation of administrative functions within the institution is necessary

for efficient and effective operations of the institution, the president or

chancellor, with approval of the institution's board of trustees, may have

- 1 the authority to transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between
- 2 campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the institution,
- 3 after receiving prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 4 Committee. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used
- 5 for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General
- 6 Assembly. The transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations which involve
- 7 academic programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher Education
- 8 prior to submission to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
- 9 Provided, however, that the institution shall be limited to submitting no
- more than four (4) individual transaction transfer requests during any fiscal 10
- 11 year and shall be further limited to no more than five percent (5%) of the
- 12 total General Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation, funding, positions
- specific to each institution, and no Tobacco Settlement funds or 13
- 14 appropriations may be reallocated pursuant to this section.
- 15 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
- 16 appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher
- 17 education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This
- 18 is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation
- 19 act(s) for institutions of higher education and the general revenue
