SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code Annotated 6-62-104, concerning Transfer of appropriation, is repealed.

Unless otherwise provided by law, each state supported institution of higher education may transfer appropriations between the various line items within each appropriation contained in its biennial appropriation act. However, such transfers shall be made only after the approval of the Department of Higher Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and after seeking the advice of the Legislative Council.

SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code Annotated 6-63-310, concerning Reorganization and consolidation of administrative functions, is repealed:

(a) Upon determination by the President of the University of Arkansas
that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or
consolidation of administrative functions within the University of Arkansas
is necessary for efficient and effective operations of the university, the
president, with approval of the Board of Trustees of the University of

1 Arkansas, may have the authority to transfer positions and related funds 2 between campuses, divisions, and other budgetary units of the university. (b)(1) The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used 3 4 for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General 5 Assembly. 6 (2) The reallocation of resources through consolidation or reorganization 7 may include the Graduate Institute of Technology, provided that the 8 appropriated funds or positions for this program shall not be transferred 9 from the central Arkansas area. 10 (3) The transfers, consolidation, or reorganization which involve academic 11 programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher Education and the 12 Legislative Council. 13 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code Annotated 6-65-225, concerning 14 15 Consolidation of administrative functions, is repealed: 16 17 (a) Upon determination by the President of Arkansas State University that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or 18 19 consolidation of administrative functions within the university is necessary 20 for efficient and effective operations of the university, the president, with 21 approval of the Board of Trustees of Arkansas State University, may have the 22 authority to transfer positions, appropriations, and related funds between 23 campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the university. 24 (b) The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used 25 for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General 26 Assembly. 27 (c) The transfers, consolidation, or reorganization which involve 28 academic programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher Education and 29 the Legislative Council. 30 31 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code Annotated 6-62-309, concerning 32 Bonds or notes - Liability, is amended by adding a subsection: 33 34 (c) Upon a determination of the board of trustees that a reallocation of resources is necessary for the purposes of preventing a default on its 35 indebtedness, the board of trustees has specific authority to transfer funds 36

1 between and among campuses, divisions and other budgetary units of its 2 institution of higher education. Upon exercising the authority to reallocate 3 resources as provided by this section, the board of trustees shall report the 4 reasons for, and the details of, such reallocations to the Legislative 5 Council or Joint Budget Committee immediately thereafter. 6 7 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 8 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EMERGENCY 9 GRANTS & EXTRA HELP POOL. An Institution of higher education that suffers an emergency/disaster event resulting in all or a significant portion of campus 10 11 operations being interrupted, may request disaster assistance through the Arkansas Department of Higher Education. Upon the declaration of an 12 emergency by the Governor, the institution may request, subject to the 13 recommendation of the Director of the Department of Higher Education and 14 15 approval of the Governor, a grant from the Disaster Relief Fund to assist in 16 returning that campus to operation and/or to a sister campus providing 17 services to the students from the affected campus. Certified law enforcement 18 officers employed by an institution of higher education may be granted jurisdiction at the sister institution, upon agreement of both institutions. 19 20 The Department of Higher Education is authorized a pool of 500 extra help positions for use in such emergency situations. These positions may be 21 22 assigned to the campus suffering the disaster event or to a sister campus 23 providing services to the students from the affected campus. The Governor 24 may waive the 1500 hour limit of ACA 6-63-314 on these assigned extra help 25 pool positions. 26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 27 through June 30, 2009. 28 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 29 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES FOR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION. Upon 31 32 determination by the president or chancellor of an institution of higher 33 education that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or 34 consolidation of administrative functions within the institution is necessary for efficient and effective operations of the institution, the president or 35 36 chancellor, with approval of the institution's board of trustees, may have

- 1 the authority to transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between
- 2 campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the institution,
- 3 <u>after receiving prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget</u>
- 4 Committee. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used
- 5 for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General
- 6 Assembly. The transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations which involve
- 7 academic programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher Education
- 8 prior to submission to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
- 9 Provided, however, that the institution shall be limited to submitting no
- 10 more than four (4) individual transaction transfer requests during any fiscal
- 11 year and shall be further limited to no more than five percent (5%) of the
- 12 <u>total General Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation, funding, positions</u>
- 13 specific to each institution, and no Tobacco Settlement funds or
- 14 appropriations may be reallocated pursuant to this section.
- 15 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
- 16 appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher
- 17 education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This
- 18 <u>is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation</u>
- 19 <u>act(s)</u> for institutions of higher education and the general revenue
- 20 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the
- 21 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that
- 22 institutions of higher education may operate more efficiently if some
- 23 flexibility is provided to institutions of higher education authorizing broad
- 24 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate
- 25 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of
- 26 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this
- 27 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
- 28 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement
- 29 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled
- 30 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is
- 31 void.

- 32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 33 through June 30, 2009.
- 35 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR

Any two-year institution of Higher Education that has 6 its main or a satellite campus located within a twenty five mile radius of 7 any four-year institution of higher education shall enter into a written 8 agreement with that four-year institution which must address duplication of 9 services between the institutions. 10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 11 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009. 12 13 SECTION 43. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 16 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 18 19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 20 21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 22 23 SECTION 44. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 24 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 25 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 26 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 27 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 29 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 30 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 31 SECTION 45. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 32 33 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 34 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of

the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
2	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
3	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
4	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
5	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
6	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
