10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE
11 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - DIVISION OF PUBLIC
12 SCHOOL ACADEMIC FACILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION FOR
13 THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2009; AND FOR
14 OTHER PURPOSES.

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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
28 the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities
29 and Transportation for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number
30 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of
31 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
32 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
33 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
34 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
35 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
36 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular



1 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
 2 successor.

21 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the
 22 Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and
 23 Transportation for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of
 24 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from
 25 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time
 26 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 27 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
 28 for the appropriate classification.

30 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 31 the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities
 32 and Transportation, to be payable from the Division of Public School Academic
 33 Facilities and Transportation Fund Account, for personal services and
 34 operating expenses of the Department of Education - Division of Public School
 35 Academic Facilities and Transportation for the biennial period ending June
 36 30, 2009, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - PROGRAMS OF THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIC FACILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation, to be payable from the Educational Facilities Partnership Fund Account, for grants and aid and special programs providing academic school facility and transportation assistance to the public school districts of the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

1 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
3 AUTHORITY. The Director of the Department of Education – Division of Public
4 School Academic Facilities and Transportation, with the approval of the Chief
5 Fiscal Officer of the State and after approval by the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee, is hereby authorized to request necessary
7 appropriation transfers and any other budget related adjustments necessary
8 for the appropriations authorized herein. Furthermore, it is the intent of
9 the General Assembly that the Department of Education - Division of Public
10 School Academic Facilities and Transportation be able to make use of
11 additional contractual services as necessary and that transfers between line
12 items and among appropriations are anticipated to accomplish those purposes.

13 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
14 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
15 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
16 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
17 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
18 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
19 has determined that the Department of Education – Division of Public School
20 Academic Facilities and Transportation may operate more efficiently if some
21 flexibility is provided to the Director of the Department of Education –
22 Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation authorizing
23 broad powers under the Transfer Authority provision herein. Therefore, it is
24 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
25 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
26 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
27 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
28 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
29 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
30 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~
32 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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34 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
36 FORWARD. The balance of the appropriations as provided in Section 4 of this

1 Act for grants and aid and special programs providing academic school
2 facility and transportation assistance to the public school district for
3 Programs of the Division of Public School Academic Facilities and
4 Transportation which remain on June 30, ~~2006~~ 2008, shall be carried forward
5 and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30,
6 ~~2007~~ 2009.

7 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as
8 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

9 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set
10 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or
11 funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

12 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
13 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
14 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the
15 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
16 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
17 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
18 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the
19 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item,
20 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request
21 set forth in (1) above;

22 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
23 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
24 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
25 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
26 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
27 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
28 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
29 Committee; and

30 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
31 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals
32 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
33 Institution.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~
35 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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1 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 3 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 4 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 11 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 17 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 18 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 20 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 21 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 22 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
 23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
 24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 25 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 26 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
 27 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 28 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 29 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
