20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-117 is amended to read as follows:
23 6-17-117. Noninstructional duties.

24 (a)(1) The purpose of this section is to provide additional time for
25 instructional purposes and to reduce the amount of time for noninstructional
26 duties.

27 (2) Any teacher assigned more than sixty (60) minutes of
28 noninstructional duties per week shall be contracted in accordance with § 6-
29 17-807(g).

30 (b) For the purpose of this section, "noninstructional duty" means the
31 supervision of students before the instructional day begins or after the
32 instructional day ~~begins or ends~~ for students ~~or for the supervision of~~
33 ~~students during breakfasts, lunches, recesses, or scheduled breaks.~~

34 (c) For the purpose of this section, "instructional purposes" means
35 activities initiated by the teacher related to teaching duties, including,
36 but not limited to, contacting parents, assessing student performance,



1 documenting student performance, organizing the classroom, preparing
2 instructional materials, and other teaching responsibilities related to
3 instructional planning and the direct instruction of students.
