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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-12-129 is amended to read as follows:
24 24-12-129. Municipal officials and employees.

25 (a) When Subsection (b) of this section only applies if any municipal
26 official or municipal employee age fifty-five (55) or over who has completed
27 twenty (20) years of service to the municipality and who is retires and:

28 (1) Is vested in the retirement system-retires;

29 (2) Has twenty-eight (28) years or more of actual service; or

30 (3) Has thirty-five (35) years of credited service in the
31 retirement system without regard to age.

32 (b) the official or employee A retired municipal official or municipal
33 employee described in subsection (a) of this section may continue to
34 participate in the municipality's health care plan, receiving the same
35 medical benefits and paying the same premium as active employees as long as
36 the retired municipal official or municipal employee pays both employer and



1 employee contributions to the health care plan.
