## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO ALLOW TIPPED FOOD SERVICE EMPLOYEES OF  
11 THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND TOURISM TO BE  
12 CONSIDERED SUBSTANTIALLY GAINFULLY EMPLOYED FOR  
13 PURPOSES OF THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'  
14 RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 TO ALLOW TIPPED FOOD SERVICE EMPLOYEES  
17 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND TOURISM  
18 TO BE CONSIDERED SUBSTANTIALLY GAINFULLY  
19 EMPLOYED FOR PURPOSES OF THE ARKANSAS  
20 PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-4-101(17)(B)(ix), concerning the  
27 definition of "employee" for purposes of membership in the Arkansas Public  
28 Employees' Retirement System, is amended to read as follows:

29 (ix)(a)(1) Persons whose rate of pay does not constitute  
30 employment that is substantially gainful shall be excluded from membership.

31 (2) A rate of pay less than the federal  
32 minimum wage for the year shall not be considered employment that is  
33 substantially gainful.

34 (b) A tipped food service employee of the Department  
35 of Parks and Tourism who is guaranteed the prevailing minimum wage by the  
36 Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, 29 U.S.C. § 201 et seq., as it existed on



1 January 1, 2009, is in employment that is substantially gainful.

2 (c) The employee and employer contributions for a  
3 tipped food service employee of the Department of Parks and Tourism is  
4 computed based on the tipped food service employee's hourly rate of pay;
