22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 78, Subchapter 1 is amended
25 to add an additional section to read as follows:

26 20-78-107. Criminal penalties for unlawful disclosure of interview
27 information from a child safety center or child advocacy center.

28 (a) It is unlawful to disclose information regarding interviews
29 conducted at a child advocacy center or child safety center in violation of
30 rules adopted by the Arkansas Child Abuse/Rape/Domestic Violence Commission
31 under this subchapter.

32 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a:

33 (1) Class A misdemeanor for the first offense;

34 (2) Class D felony for the second offense; and

35 (3) Class C felony for the third offense and subsequent
