9 JONES UPON BEING NAMED THE NATIONAL FEDERATION OF  
10 STATE HIGH SCHOOL ASSOCIATIONS' FOOTBALL COACH OF THE  
11 YEAR.

15 TO HONOR GREENWOOD HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL  
16 COACH RICK JONES UPON BEING NAMED THE  
17 NATIONAL FEDERATION OF STATE HIGH SCHOOL  
18 ASSOCIATIONS' FOOTBALL COACH OF THE YEAR.

21 WHEREAS, the Greenwood High School Bulldogs football team won the third  
22 consecutive state championship title under the tutelage of Head Coach Rick  
23 Jones; and

24  
25 WHEREAS, The Greenwood Bulldogs established a perfect record of 14-0  
26 for the second consecutive season, despite moving up to the 6A classification  
27 for the first time; and

28  
29 WHEREAS, the Greenwood Bulldogs not only led the state in scoring in  
30 2012, but also established a new single-season school scoring record with 663  
31 points, averaging over 47 points per game; and

32  
33 WHEREAS, the Greenwood Bulldogs extended their winning streak to 38  
34 games, which matches the third-longest winning streak in the history of  
35 Arkansas high school football; and

1           WHEREAS, Greenwood Bulldogs have captured 7 conference championships in  
2 the past 9 seasons and 7 state football championships in the past 14 seasons;

5           WHEREAS, Coach Rick Jones has an overall Arkansas state playoff record  
6 of 30 wins and 3 losses; and  
7

8           WHEREAS, Coach Rick Jones has posted an incredible win-loss record of  
9 107-16, an impressive 87% winning percentage, during his 9-year tenure at  
10 Greenwood High School; and  
11

12           WHEREAS, Coach Rick Jones has an overall 239-64 win-loss record in his  
13 stellar coaching career; and  
14

15           WHEREAS, Coach Rick Jones has been recognized 13 times in Arkansas and  
16 Oklahoma as the Coach of the Year, including being named the 2012 Coach of  
17 the Year by the Southwest Times Record and the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette; and  
18

19           WHEREAS, Coach Rick Jones was recently inducted into the Oklahoma  
20 Coaches Association Hall of Fame; and

22           WHEREAS, the National Federation of State High School Associations, of  
23 which the Arkansas Activities Association is a member, has honored Coach Rick  
24 Jones of Greenwood, Arkansas, as the 2012 National High School Football Coach  
25 of the Year,

27 NOW THEREFORE,

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL  
29 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

31           THAT Coach Rick Jones be honored for his impressive coaching record,  
32 yet another outstanding season, and his national recognition from the  
33 National Federation of State High School Associations as the 2012 National  
34 High School Football Coach of the Year.

36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon its adoption a copy of this resolution be

1 presented to Coach Rick Jones, Head Football Coach of the Greenwood Bulldogs,  
2 and mailed to the Arkansas Activities Association and the Superintendent and  
3 the Athletic Director of Greenwood High School.
