23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

3 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -  
4 Arkansas School for the Deaf, to be payable from the Development and  
5 Enhancement Fund, the following:

6 (A) for various maintenance, renovation, equipping, construction,  
7 acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair of real property and facilities  
8 at the Arkansas School for the Deaf campus, in a sum not to  
9 exceed.....\$15,000,000.

10  
11 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL, AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS  
13 SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND - TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon approval from the Chief  
14 Fiscal Officer of the State, the Arkansas School for the Blind shall transfer  
15 appropriation from the Summer Projects line item, in the State Operations  
16 Appropriation of this Act, to the Regular Salaries, Extra Help, Personal  
17 Services Matching, Overtime and Maintenance & General Operations line items  
18 in the State Operations Appropriation of this Act, to compensate staff who  
19 work during the summer months on summer projects, and to cover other expenses  
20 of summer project activities. The Summer Projects line item may also be used  
21 for the annual cost related to the compensation of eligible staff for shift  
22 differential pay as well as compensation of employees for performance of  
23 duties assigned as referenced in the Special Allowance Special Language  
24 Section of this Act. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as  
25 exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees.

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~  
27 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

28  
29 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS  
31 SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND - SPECIAL ALLOWANCE. The Arkansas School for the Blind  
32 may make special allowances available to any employee who performs one of the  
33 following duties in addition to their normal duties:

- 34 1) Teaching adult education classes, parent training, student tutorial  
35 services on weekends or evenings
- 36 2) Coaching one or more sports

1           3) Sponsoring a club or organization that involves additional hours  
2           outside of the normal working day

3           4) Interpretive Services

4    Compensation for additional duties may not exceed \$3,500 per school term for  
5    any one employee during each fiscal year. Such pay shall not be construed as  
6    exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said position.

7           The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~  
8    2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

9  
10           SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
11    CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS  
12    SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND - BRAILLE AND LARGE PRINT TEXTBOOKS. The State Board of  
13    Education shall make reasonable rules and regulations to implement the  
14    Braille and Large Print Textbooks appropriation and is hereby authorized to  
15    negotiate directly with publishers of Braille and Large Print Textbooks for  
16    the purchase of such textbooks. The Arkansas School for the Blind (ASB) is  
17    authorized to use funds from this account for costs associated with providing  
18    Braille Textbooks and Large Print Textbooks to public schools. If funding  
19    allows and the need is present, the Arkansas School for the Blind is  
20    authorized to use funds from this account to purchase electronic textbooks,  
21    adaptive technology, and library media.

22           The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~  
23    2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

24  
25           SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
26    CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS  
27    SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND - ADDITIONAL SALARY/COMPENSATION PROVISION. No employee  
28    drawing a salary or other form of compensation from the Arkansas Schools for  
29    the Deaf or Blind shall be paid an additional salary or receive additional  
30    compensation, other than reimbursement for actual expenses, from that agency,  
31    nor from any other agency or institution of higher education, except from the  
32    Superintendent's written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal  
33    Officer of the State that the work performed by the employee for the other  
34    position does not interfere with the proper and required performance of the  
35    employee's primary duties, and that the combined salary payments from both  
36    positions will not exceed the maximum annual salary for whichever of the two

1 positions has the higher authorized maximum annual salary.

2 Any employee knowingly violating the provisions of this section shall be  
3 subject to immediate termination and shall be barred from employment by any  
4 agency or institution of the State of Arkansas for a period of not less than  
5 three (3) years or until such employee shall repay to the State of Arkansas  
6 any sums received by such employee in violation of this section, together  
7 with interest at a rate of ten percent (10%) per annum.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~  
9 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

10

11 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADE - ASB  
13 - SUMMER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the  
14 regular school term, also work during summer months shall be authorized as  
15 additional compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary  
16 for each month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall  
17 not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said  
18 employees. Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees  
19 in the following classifications:
