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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 9, Subchapter 3, is amended
27 to add an additional section to read as follows:

28 20-9-314. Hospital pricing transparency – Legislative findings.

29 (a) The General Assembly finds that:

30 (1) Under 45 C.F.R. Part 180, each hospital operating in the
31 United States is required to provide clear, accessible pricing information
32 online about the items and services that the hospital provides; and

33 (2) Easy-to-understand pricing information is essential to
34 support patients, prevent fraud, and protect consumers from unfair medical
35 bills.

36 (b)(1) A hospital licensed in this state shall comply with 45 C.F.R.



1 Part 180, as existing on January 1, 2023.

2 (2) If the Department of Health finds that a hospital licensed
3 in this state has not complied with 45 C.F.R. Part 180, as existing on
4 January 1, 2023, then the department shall fine the hospital two hundred
5 fifty dollars (\$250) per day for noncompliance.

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7 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after six (6)
8 months from the enactment of this act.
