23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-60-214(a), concerning the eligibil	ity
26	requirements for tuition benefits for soldiers and airmen of the Arkan	sas
27	National Guard, is amended to read as follows:	
28	(a) A soldier or airman of the Arkansas National Guard may atte	nd a
29	state-supported institution of higher education tuition-free if the so	ldier
30	or airman:	
31	(1) Is an Arkansas resident or is eligible for in-state t	uition
32	under § 6-60-205;	
33	(2) Except as provided in subdivision (f)(3) of this sect	ion,
34	has completed initial active duty training;	
35	(3) Except as provided in subsection (f) of this section,	is in
36	good standing as an active soldier or airman of the Arkansas National	Guard;

1	(4) Has been accepted to and is enrolled in a state-supported
2	institution of higher education as a student in good standing;
3	(5) Completed and submitted to the United States Department of
4	Education a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
5	(6) Submitted applications for:
6	(A) Federal and state grants and scholarships for which
7	the soldier or airman is eligible; and
8	(B) Grants and scholarships awarded by the state-supported
9	institution of higher education in which the soldier or airman is enrolled;
10	(7) Is enrolled in a program of study leading to an
11	undergraduate degree or a postsecondary credential or certificate; and
12	(8) Has not received a bachelor's degree.
