26	SECTION 1. Unde	r the authority granted by Arkansas	s Constitution,
27	Amendment 51, § 19, Ar	kansas Constitution, Amendment 51,	§ 6(a)(2)(G),
28	concerning statements	informing voter registration applic	cants, is amended to
29	read as follows:		
30	(G)	Inform the applicant that if the v	voter registration
31	application is being c	collected by a third-party voter re	gistration
32	organization, the thir	d-party voter registration organiza	ation may be unable
33	to deliver the applica	tion to the permanent registrar in	the county in which
34	the applicant resides	before the thirty-day pre-election	voter registration
35	deadline <u>under Arkansa</u>	s Constitution, Amendment 51, § 9(1	o)(1) to vote in the
36	next election and that	the applicant may elect to deliver	r the application in

person or by mail; and

- SECTION 2. Under the authority granted by Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 19, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 8(a), concerning the processing of voter registration applications, is amended to read as follows:
- (a)(1) The Office of Driver Services, State Revenue Offices state revenue offices, public assistance agencies, disabilities agencies, and other voter registration agencies shall transmit all completed voter registration applications to the Secretary of State in sufficient time to allow the Secretary of State to transmit the applications to the appropriate permanent registrar no later than ten (10) days after the date of acceptance by the assisting agency. When applications are accepted within five (5) days before the last day of for an election under Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 9(b)(1), they must be transmitted no later than five (5) days after the date of acceptance at the assisting agency.
- registration applications to the appropriate permanent registrar no later than ten (10) days after the date of receipt. When applications are received within five (5) days before the last day of <u>pre-election</u> registration for an election <u>under Arkansas Constitution</u>, <u>Amendment 51</u>, § 9(b)(1), they must be transmitted no later than five (5) days after date of receipt. If forms are received by the wrong election office, they shall be forwarded to the appropriate permanent registrar not later than the fifth day after receipt.

- SECTION 3. Under the authority granted by Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 19, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 9(b), concerning the voter registration deadline, is amended to read as follows:
- (b)(1) Except as otherwise provided in subdivision (b)(2) of this section, Registration registration shall be in progress at all times except during the thirty-day period immediately prior to any election scheduled within the county, during which period registration of voters shall cease for that election, but registration during such period shall be effective for subsequent elections.
  - (2) Registration shall be permitted:
    - (A) During early voting for a person appearing in person

1	at an early voting location; and
2	(B) On election day for a person appearing in person at a
3	polling site or a vote center established in his or her county of residence.
4	
5	SECTION 4. Under the authority granted by Arkansas Constitution,
6	Amendment 51, § 19, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 9(c)(2),
7	concerning voter registration submitted to the permanent registrar, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	(2) Any person who assists applicants with a voter registration
10	application as part of a voter registration drive or who, in furtherance of a
11	voter registration drive, gathers or possesses completed applications for
12	submission to the permanent registrar or Secretary of State shall deliver all
13	applications in his or her possession to the permanent registrar or Secretary
14	of State within twenty-one (21) days of the date on the voter registration
15	application and, in any event, no later than the deadline for <u>pre-election</u>
16	voter registration for the next election under Arkansas Constitution,
17	Amendment 51, § 9(b)(1).
18	
19	SECTION 5. Under the authority granted by Arkansas Constitution,
20	Amendment 51, § 19, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 10(b)(2),
21	concerning updating voter registration, is amended to read as follows:
22	(2) $(A)$ If the updated registration information is actually
23	received in the office of the county clerk of the voter's new county not
24	later than four (4) days before a scheduled election, the voter shall have
25	the right to vote in the scheduled election in the precinct into which the
26	voter just moved in the new county.
27	(B) If the updated registration information is not
28	actually received by the fourth day before a scheduled election, the voter
29	shall not be eligible to vote in the scheduled election $\underline{\text{may}}$ update his or his
30	voter registration in accordance with subsection (g) of this section.
31	
32	SECTION 6. Under the authority granted by Arkansas Constitution,
33	Amendment 51, § 19, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 10(c), concerning
34	the deadline to change legal residence on voter registration, is amended to
35	read as follows:

(c) If the change of legal residence is made pursuant to subsection

1	(a) or subdivision (d)(l) of this section following the deadline for pre-
2	election voter registration during the thirty-day administrative cut-off
3	period under Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 9(b)(1) immediately prior
4	to any election scheduled within the county, the registered voter shall
5	retain his or her right to vote in the scheduled election in the precinct to
6	which he or she just moved.
7	
8	SECTION 7. Under the authority granted by Arkansas Constitution,
9	Amendment 51, § 19, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 10, concerning
10	transfer and change of status for voter registration, is amended to add an
11	additional subsection to read as follows:
12	(g) A person appearing in person on election day or during early
13	voting at an open polling site, a vote center, or an early voting location
14	established in his or her county of residence may update his or her voter
15	registration on the same day as his or her appearance in accordance with $\S$ 7-
16	<u>5-113.</u>
17	
18	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 7-1-113(c)(3), concerning duties of an
19	election official before a person is permitted to cast a vote at a vote
20	center, is amended to read as follows:
21	(3) If the voter's name or address is not the same as that in
22	the county voter registration record files, request that the voter complete
23	an updated voter registration application form in accordance with § 7-5-113;
24	and
25	
26	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code Title 7, Chapter 5, is amended to add an
27	additional section to read as follows:
28	7-5-113. Voter registration on election day or during early voting.
29	(a) A person appearing in person on election day or during early
30	voting at an open polling site, a vote center, or an early voting location
31	established in his or her county of residence is eligible to register to vote
32	or update registration on the same day as his or her appearance.
33	(b) To register or update registration and vote under subsection (a)
34	of this section:
35	(1) The person shall:
36	(A) Register in the manner set forth by Arkansas

1	Constitution, Amendment 51; or
2	(B) Update his or her registration by completing an
3	updated voter registration application;
4	(2) The person shall sign a written eligibility affirmation
5	under penalty of perjury in the presence of a poll worker that he or she is
6	eligible to vote and has not already voted in the election in any county in
7	the state;
8	(3) The poll worker shall verify that the person has not already
9	voted in the election in any county in the state; and
10	(4) The poll worker shall update the voter registration records
11	in a manner immediately evident to every open polling site, vote center, and
12	early voting location in every county in the state to indicate that the
13	person has voted in the election.
14	(c)(l) If the poll worker is unable to complete the required duties in
15	subdivisions (b)(3) or (b)(4) of this section, the voter may cast $a$
16	provisional ballot in accordance with the procedures in § 7-5-308.
17	(2) Unless enjoined by a court with jurisdiction, a provisional
18	ballot under this subsection shall be counted if:
19	(A) The voter returns to the county board of election
20	commissioners or the county clerk by 12:00 noon on the Monday following the
21	election and presents documentation that allows the county board of election
22	commissioners or the county clerk to verify the requirements in subdivisions
23	(b)(3) and (b)(4) of this section; and
24	(B) The county board of election commissioners does not
25	determine that the provisional ballot is invalid and should not be counted
26	based on other grounds.
27	(d) Poll workers shall maintain an additional list in the same format
28	as the precinct voter registration list for all persons who register to vote
29	or update voter registration under this section which shall be considered
30	part of the precinct voter registration list.
31	
32	SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 7-5-201(a), concerning voter
33	qualifications, is amended to read as follows:
34	(a) To be qualified to vote, a person shall have registered at least
35	thirty (30) calendar days immediately prior to the election and in the manner
36	set forth by Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51.

2	SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 7-5-305(a)(5) and (6), concerning poll	
3	worker duties before a person is permitted to vote, is amended to read as	
4	follows:	
5	(5)(A) If the voter's address is not the same as that on the	
6	precinct voter registration list, verify with the county clerk that the	
7	address is within the precinct.	
8	(B) If the address is within the precinct, request the	
9	voter to complete a voter registration application form for the purpose of	
10	updating county voter registration record files in accordance with § 7-5-113.	
11	(C) If the address is not within the precinct:	
12	(i) Verify with the county clerk's office the proper	
13	precinct; and	
14	(ii) Instruct the voter to go to the polling site	
15	serving that precinct in order for his or her vote to be counted;	
16	(6) If the voter's name is not the same as that on the precinct	
17	voter registration list, request the voter to complete a voter registration	
18	application form for purposes of updating county voter registration record	
19	files in accordance with § 7-5-113;

21	SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 7-5-306(a), concerning procedure when a	
22	voter's name is not on the precinct voter registration list, is amended to	
23	read as follows:	
24	(a) If $\frac{1}{2}$ voter's name is not on the precinct voter registration	
25	list, the poll worker shall permit the voter to vote only under the following	
26	conditions voter shall not vote until the voter registers or updates his or	
27	her registration in accordance with § 7-5-113.÷	
28	(1) The voter identifies himself or herself by stating his or	
29	her name and date of birth and is verified by the county clerk as a	
30	registered voter within the county and, if the county is divided into more	
31	than one (1) congressional district, within the same congressional district;	
32	(2) The voter gives and affirms his or her current residence and	
33	the poll worker verifies with the county clerk that the voter's residence is	
34	within the precinct;	
35	(3) The voter completes an updated voter registration
