31		SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determine	ned by the General		
32	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the				
33	appro	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the			
34	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to the operation of				
35	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in				
36	the e	event of an extension of the legislative session, the d	elay in the		

effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2025 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2025.
