## Subtitle

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16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN  
17 SERVICES - DIVISION OF COUNTY OPERATIONS  
18 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2025-2026 FISCAL

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
26 for the Department of Human Services - Division of County Operations for the

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28 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for  
 29 the Department of Human Services - Division of County Operations - Operations  
 30 for the 2025-2026 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or  
 31 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
 32 appropriated herein for such purposes: forty-three (43) temporary or part-  
 33 time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in  
 34 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this  
 35 act for the appropriate classification.

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1 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 2 to the Department of Human Services, to be payable from the paying account as

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15 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER

17 OF TANF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS. Each fiscal year, the Department of Human

18 Services shall transfer the sum of seven million five hundred thousand

19 dollars (\$7,500,000) from the state’s federal Temporary Assistance for Needy

20 Families block grant to the Department of Education Division of Elementary

21 and Secondary Education Public School Fund Account to be used solely for the

22 Arkansas Better Chance Program.

23 If the state match for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant

24 or the state’s Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant is reduced, the

25 amount to be transferred may be adjusted in proportion to the percentage

26 change in the state match or the state’s Temporary Assistance for Needy

27 Families grant. The amount to be transferred may also be reduced

28 proportionately if new cost requirements are imposed upon the state as a

29 result of new or revised Temporary Assistance for Needy Families regulations

30 at the federal level.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2024~~

32 2025 through June 30, ~~2025~~ 2026.

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34 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

36 RESTRICTIONS ON FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY

## 1 FAMILIES PROGRAM.

2 (a)(1) Determining the maximum number of employees, the maximum amount  
3 of appropriation, for what purposes an appropriation is authorized, and  
4 general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the  
5 prerogative of the General Assembly.

6 (2) The purposes of subsection (a) of this section are typically  
7 accomplished by:

8 (A) Identifying the purpose in the appropriation act;

9 (B) Delineating such maximums in the appropriation act for a  
10 state agency; and

11 (C) Delineating the general revenue allocations authorized for  
12 each fund and fund account by amendment to the revenue stabilization law.

13 (3) It is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly  
14 restrict the use of appropriations authorized in this act.

15 (b)(1) Upon the request of the Governor or the General Assembly, the  
16 Department of Human Services shall request a waiver from the federal  
17 government to:

18 (A) Restrict the financial assistance granted to a recipient of  
19 the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program or its successor program  
20 to purchase goods and services that are considered essential and necessary  
21 for the welfare of the family, including without limitation:

22 (i) Food;

23 (ii) Clothing;

24 (iii) Housing;

25 (iv) Utilities;

26 (v) Child care; and

27 (vi) Incidentals, including without limitation  
28 transportation and medicine or medical supplies or equipment not covered by  
29 either the Arkansas Medicaid Program or the health benefit plan of the  
30 individual; and

31 (B) Restrict the cash withdrawal from an electronic benefit  
32 transfer card account that receives financial assistance under the Temporary  
33 Assistance for Needy Families Program or its successor program by electronic  
34 benefit transfer system.

35 (2) If the federal government denies the waiver application, this  
36 section shall not be implemented.

1 (3) If the division does not request a wavier under subdivision  
2 (b)(1) of this section, the department shall not allocate, budget, expend, or  
3 utilize appropriations under this act for the participation of persons in the  
4 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2024~~  
6 2025 through June 30, ~~2025~~ 2026.

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8 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
14 controllaws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
28 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
29 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to the operation of  
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2025 could work irreparable harm  
34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
36 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health



1 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2025.

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
