4	(2) In order to make the determination required under	
5	subdivision (a)(1) of this section, the division and the commission shall	
6	study relevant data and risk factors, including without limitation the	
7	earliest age at which:	
8	(A) Incidents of injury involving firearms are reported;	
9	<u>and</u>	
10	(B) Children are susceptible to harm from unsecured	
11	firearms that they are able to gain access to.	
12	(c) Beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, each public school	
13	district and open-enrollment public charter school shall annually provide	
14	students with age-appropriate and grade-appropriate instruction on firearm	
15	safety.	
16	(d) The curriculum or program of instruction used to educate students	
17	on firearm safety under subsection (b) of this section shall:	
18	(1) Be approved by the division;	
19	(2) Begin in the earliest appropriate grade as determined by the	
20	division and the commission under subsection (a) of this section and continu	
21	in each subsequent grade through grade twelve (12);	
22	(3) Include instruction on the following without limitation:	
23	(A) The proper handling and safe storage of firearms;	
24	(B) School safety relating to firearms; and	
25	(C) The steps to take if a student finds an unsecured	
26	firearm, including without limitation the importance of:	
27	(i) Avoiding injury if the student finds an	
28	unsecured firearm;	
29	(ii) Never touching a firearm if the student finds	
30	an unsecured firearm; and	
31	(iii) Immediately notifying an adult of the location	
32	of the unsecured firearm; and	
33	(4) Include neutral viewpoints on all included topics, includin	
34	without limitation:	
35	(A) Gun rights and the Second Amendment to the United	
36	States Constitution; and	

1	(B) The prevention of accidental firearm injury.
2	(e)(1) The division shall not approve a curriculum or program of
3	instruction used to educate students on firearm safety if the curriculum,
4	program of instruction, or any of the instructional materials used as part of
5	the curriculum or program of instruction bear a brand or stated
6	organizational affiliation.
7	(2) However, curricula, programs of instruction, or any of the
8	instructional materials used as part of the curricula or programs of
9	instruction used to educate students on firearm safety may bear a brand
10	issued by the State of Arkansas or any of its departments, agencies, or
11	divisions.
12	(f) The division shall determine the means by which the curriculum or
13	program of instruction used to educate students on firearm safety required
14	under this section shall be provided, which shall be through:
15	(1)(A) A commission-approved firearm safety course, which may
16	include a firearm safety course that is provided in conjunction with a live-
17	fire exercise or sporting event.
18	(B) If a commission-approved firearm safety course is
19	provided in conjunction with a live-fire exercise or sporting event, a
20	participating student shall obtain written approval from his or her parent,
21	legal guardian, or person standing in loco parentis to the student;
22	(2) The viewing of a video; or
23	(3) The review of online resources and materials.
24	(g) As used in this section, "firearm" means the same as defined in §
25	<u>5-1-102.</u>
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
