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24	SECTION 1. EXTRA H	HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby	authorized, for
25	the Arkansas Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee		
26	for the 2024-2025 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or		
27	temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds

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33	SECTION 2. APPROPE	RIATION OPERATIONS. There is hereby	y appropriated, to

35	to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for operating expenses of

COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 10 11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 18 19 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 27 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 28 29 General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of the Arkansas Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint 30 31 Auditing Committee are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the 32 Arkansas Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of 33 34 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas Legislative Audit 35 of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee to continue such services; and

that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm

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1	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental		
2	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
3	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health		
4	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its		
5	passage and approval.		
6	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall		
7	become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the		
8	Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the		
9	veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house		
10	overrides the veto.		
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
