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10       SECTION 13. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS - UNRESTRICTED SETTLEMENT FEES  
 11 AND OTHER CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of  
 12 Attorney General, to be payable from the cash funds as defined by Arkansas  
 13 Code 19-4-801, for personal services, miscellaneous operating expenses,  
 14 grants, court order payments, consumer education and enforcement activities  
 15 from unrestricted settlement fees and other cash funds of the Office of  
 16 Attorney General for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, the sum  
 17 of.....\$10,000,000.

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19       SECTION 14. APPROPRIATION - SETTLEMENT FEES AND RESTITUTION. There is  
 20 hereby appropriated, to the Office of Attorney General, to be payable from  
 21 the cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for personal services,  
 22 miscellaneous operating expenses, grants, fund transfers, and restitution  
 23 payments and expenses of the Office of Attorney General for the fiscal year  
 24 ending June 30, 2026, the sum of.....\$31,000.

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26       SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
 28 TRANSFER PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer  
 29 of the State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
 30 Budget Committee, the Office of Attorney General is authorized to transfer  
 31 appropriation from any line item authorized in the Operations Appropriation  
 32 of the Office of Attorney General in this Act to any other line item  
 33 authorized in the Operations Appropriation.

34       The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2024  
 35 2025 through June 30, ~~2025~~ 2026.

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1 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
3 FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Attorney  
4 General may deposit or transfer by check monies from the unobligated cash  
5 funds of the Office of Attorney General received from court orders or  
6 settlement agreements to the State Central Services Fund.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2024~~  
8 2025 through June 30, ~~2025~~ 2026.

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10 SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
11 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
13 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
30 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
31 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to the operation of  
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
35 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2025 could work irreparable harm  
36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental



1 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
2 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
3 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2025.

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
