15	TO CREATE THE ARKANSAS PRIVACY ACT; AND	
16	TO ADDRESS CERTAIN IMAGES CAPTURED BY	
17	UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS.

19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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21	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Title.</u>	
22	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Arkansas Privacy	Act".
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24	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-60-103 is amended to read as follow	s:
25	5-60-103. Unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system related to	
26	infrastructure - Unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system related to	· •
27	images.	
28	(a) As used in this section:	
29	(1) "Critical infrastructure" means:	
30	(A) An electrical power generation or delivery syste	m;
31	(B) A petroleum refinery;	
32	(C) A chemical or rubber manufacturing facility;	
33	(D) A petroleum or chemical storage facility;	
34	(E) A railroad operating facility;	
35	(F) A communication tower or facility;	
36	(G) A food processing or manufacturing facility; or	

1	(H) A correctional or detention facility; and
2	(2)(A) "Image" means a capturing of sound waves, thermal,
3	infrared, ultraviolet, or visible light, or other electromagnetic waves,
4	odor, or other conditions existing on or about real property or an individual
5	located on the real property; and
6	(3)(A) "Unmanned aircraft system" means an unmanned, powered
7	aircraft that:
8	(i) Does not carry a human operator;
9	(ii) Can be autonomous or remotely piloted or
10	operated; and
11	(iii) Can be expendable or recoverable.
12	(B) "Unmanned aircraft system" does not include:
13	(i) A satellite orbiting the earth;
14	(ii) An unmanned aircraft system used by the United
15	States Government or a person who is acting pursuant to contract with the
16	United States Government to conduct surveillance of specific critical
17	infrastructure;
18	(iii) An unmanned aircraft system used by the state
19	after consultation with the Governor or a person who is acting under contract
20	with the state to conduct surveillance of specific critical infrastructure;
21	(iv) An unmanned aircraft system used under a
22	certificate of authorization issued by the Federal Aviation Administration;
23	or
24	(v) An unmanned aircraft used by a law enforcement
25	agency, emergency medical service agency, hazardous materials response team,
26	disaster management agency, or other emergency management agency for the
27	purpose of incident command, area reconnaissance, personnel and equipment
28	deployment monitoring, training, or a related purpose.
29	(b) A person commits the offense of unlawful use of an unmanned
30	aircraft system related to critical infrastructure if he or she knowingly
31	uses an unmanned aircraft system to conduct surveillance of, gather evidence
32	or collect information about, or photographically or electronically record
33	critical infrastructure without the prior written consent of the owner of the
34	critical infrastructure.
35	(c) This Subsection (b) of this section does not prohibit:
36	(1)(A) A person from using an unmanned aircraft system to

1	conduct surveillance of, gather evidence or collect information about, or
2	photographically or electronically record his or her own property that is:
3	(i) Located on his or her own immovable property; or
4	(ii) Located on immovable property owned by another
5	person under a valid lease, servitude, right-of-way, right of use, permit,
6	license, or other right.
7	(B) A third person retained by the owner of the property
8	described in subdivision (c)(1)(A) of this section to conduct activities
9	described in subdivision (c)(1)(A) of this section is not prohibited under
10	this section from using an unmanned aircraft system to conduct the activities
11	described in this subdivision (c)(l); or
12	(2) An insurance company or a person acting on behalf of an
13	insurance company from using an unmanned aircraft system for purposes of
14	underwriting an insurance risk or investigating damage to insured property.
15	(d) Unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system related to critical
16	infrastructure is:
17	(1) A Class B misdemeanor; or
18	(2) A Class A misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense.
19	(e)(1) A person commits the offense of unlawful use of an unmanned
20	aircraft system related to images if the person purposely uses an unmanned
21	aircraft system to capture an image of an individual or private property with
22	the purpose to conduct surveillance on the individual or private property
23	captured in the image.
24	(2) It is a defense to prosecution under subdivision (e)(1) of
25	this section that the person:
26	(A) Destroyed the image:
27	(i) As soon as the person had knowledge that the
28	image was captured in violation of this section; and
29	(ii) Without disclosing, displaying, or distributing
30	the image to another person; or
31	(B) Captured the image lawfully as authorized under § 27-
32	<u>5-101.</u>
33	(f) Unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system related to images is a
34	Class C misdemeanor.
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36	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 60, Subchapter 1, is amended

1	to add an additional section to read as follows:
2	5-60-126. Unlawful possession, disclosure, display, distribution, or
3	use of an image captured by an unmanned aircraft system.
4	(a) A person commits the offense of unlawful possession, disclosure,
5	display, distribution, or use of an image captured by an unmanned aircraft
6	<pre>system if the person:</pre>
7	(1) Captures an image in violation of § 5-60-103; and
8	(2) Possesses, discloses, displays, distributes, or otherwise
9	uses the image captured in violation of § 5-60-103.
10	(b) Unlawful possession, disclosure, display, distribution, or use of
11	an image captured by an unmanned aircraft system is a:
12	(1) Class C misdemeanor if the person only possessed an image in
13	violation of § 5-60-103; or
14	(2) Class B misdemeanor if otherwise committed.
15	(c) Each image a person possesses, discloses, displays, distributes,
16	or otherwise uses in violation of this section is a separate offense.
17	(d) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that the person:
18	(1) Destroyed the image as soon as the person had knowledge that
19	the image was captured in violation of § 5-60-103 for a charge related to
20	possession;
21	(2) Stopped disclosing, displaying, distributing, or otherwise
22	using the image as soon as the person had knowledge that the image was
23	captured in violation of § 5-60-103 for a charge related to disclosure,
24	display, distribution, or other use of an image; or
25	(3) Captured the image lawfully as authorized under § 27-5-101.
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27	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 6, Subchapter 7, is amended
28	to add an additional section to read as follows:
29	12-6-703. Rules on use of unmanned aircraft system by law enforcement
30	— Reporting.
31	(a) The Department of Public Safety shall adopt rules for the use of
32	an unmanned aircraft system by a law enforcement agency in this state.
33	(b) By January 15 of each odd-numbered year, each state law
34	enforcement agency and each county or municipal law enforcement agency
35	located in a county or municipality, as applicable, with a population greater
36	than one hundred fifty thousand (150,000), that used or operated an unmanned

1	aircraft system during the preceding twenty-four (24) months shall:
2	(1) Issue a report to the Governor and the General Assembly;
3	(2) Retain the report required by subdivision (b)(1) of this
4	section for public viewing; and
5	(3) Post the report required by subdivision (b)(1) of this
6	section on the law enforcement agency's publicly accessible website, if the
7	law enforcement agency has a publicly accessible website.
8	(c) The report required by subdivision (b)(l) of this section shall
9	include the:
10	(1) Number of times an unmanned aircraft system was used,
11	organized by date, time, location, and the type of incidents and
12	justification for the use;
13	(2) Number of criminal investigations aided by the use of an
14	unmanned aircraft system and a description of how the unmanned aircraft
15	system aided each criminal investigation;
16	(3) Number of times an unmanned aircraft system was used for a
17	law enforcement operation other than a criminal investigation, the date and
18	location of each law enforcement operation other than a criminal
19	investigation, and a description of how the unmanned aircraft system aided
20	each law enforcement operation other than a criminal investigation;
21	(4) Type of information collected on an individual, residence,
22	property, or area that was not the subject of a law enforcement operation
23	other than a criminal investigation and the frequency of the collection of
24	this information; and
25	(5) Total cost of acquiring, maintaining, repairing, and
26	operating or otherwise using each unmanned aircraft system for the preceding
27	twenty-four (24) months.
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29	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 40, Subchapter 1, is
30	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
31	16-40-108. Illegally or incidentally captured images not subject to
32	<u>disclosure - Definitions.</u>
33	(a) As used in this section:
34	(1) "Image" means the same as defined in § 5-60-103; and
35	(2) "Unmanned aircraft system" means the same as defined in § 5-
36	60-103.

1	(b) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (c) of this section, an
2	image captured in violation of § 5-60-103 or an image captured by an unmanned
3	aircraft system that was incidental to the lawful capturing of an image:
4	(1) May not be used as evidence in any criminal proceeding,
5	juvenile proceeding, civil action, or administrative proceeding;
6	(2) Is not subject to disclosure, inspection, or copying under
7	the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.; and
8	(3) Is not subject to discovery, subpoena, or other means of
9	<u>legal</u> compulsion for its release.
10	(c) An image described by subsection (b) of this section may be
11	disclosed and used as evidence to prove a violation of § $5-60-103$ and is
12	subject to discovery, subpoena, or other means of legal compulsion for the
13	purpose of proving a violation of § 5-60-103.
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15	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 118, Subchapter 1, is
16	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
17	16-118-119. Civil action for damages caused by violation of §§ 5-60-
18	103 and 5-60-126 — Definition.
19	(a) As used in this section, "malice" means a specific intent by a
20	person to cause substantial injury or harm to an owner or tenant of private
21	real property.
22	(b) An owner or tenant of private real property may bring an action
23	against a person who, in violation of § 5-60-103, captured an image of the
24	private real property or the owner or tenant of the private real property
25	while on the private real property to:
26	(1) Enjoin a violation or imminent violation of § 5-60-103 or §
27	<u>5-60-126;</u>
28	(2) Recover a civil damage of:
29	(A) Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for all images captured
30	in a single episode in violation of § 5-60-103; or
31	(B) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for disclosure,
32	display, distribution, or other use of an image captured in a single episode
33	in violation of § 5-60-126; or
34	(3) Recover actual damages if the person who captured the image
35	in violation of § 5-60-103 discloses, displays, or distributes the image with
36	malice.

1	(c) For purposes of recovering the civil damages or actual damages
2	under subsection (b) of this section:
3	(1) All owners of a parcel of real property are considered to be
4	a single owner; and
5	(2) All tenants of a parcel of real property are considered to
6	be a single tenant.
7	(d) In addition to the civil damages and actual damages authorized
8	under this section, the court shall award court costs and reasonable
9	attorney's fees to the prevailing party in an action under this section.
10	(e) An action brought under this section shall be commenced within two
11	(2) years from the date the image was:
12	(1) Captured in violation of § 5-60-103; or
13	(2) Initially disclosed, displayed, distributed, or otherwise
14	used in violation of § 5-60-126.
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16	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code Title 27, Subtitle 8, is amended to add an
17	additional chapter to read as follows:
18	CHAPTER 118
19	<u>UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS</u>
20	
21	27-118-101. Use of unmanned aircraft system to capture image.
22	(a) As used in this section, "unmanned aircraft system" means the same
23	<u>as defined in § 5-60-103.</u>
24	(b) It is lawful to capture an image using an unmanned aircraft system
25	in this state:
26	(1) For purposes of professional or scholarly research and
27	development by a person acting on behalf of an institution of higher
28	education, including without limitation a person who is:
29	(A) A professor, an employee, or a student of the
30	institution of higher education; or
31	(B) Under contract with or otherwise acting under the
32	direction of or on behalf of the institution of higher education;
33	(2) In airspace designated as a test site or range authorized by
34	the Federal Aviation Administration for the purpose of integrating unmanned
35	aircraft systems into the national airspace;
36	(3) As part of an operation, exercise, or mission of the United

1	States Armed Forces;
2	(4) If the image is captured by a satellite for the purposes of
3	mapping;
4	(5) If the image is captured by or for an electric utility or
5	natural gas utility:
6	(A) For operations and maintenance of utility facilities
7	for the purpose of maintaining utility system reliability and integrity;
8	(B) For inspecting utility facilities to determine repair,
9	maintenance, or replacement needs during and after construction of the
10	<pre>facilities;</pre>
11	(C) For assessing vegetation growth for the purpose of
12	maintaining clearances on utility easements; and
13	(D) For utility facility routing and siting for the
14	purpose of providing utility service;
15	(6) With the consent of the individual who owns or lawfully
16	occupies the real property captured in the image;
17	(7) Pursuant to a valid search or arrest warrant;
18	(8) If the image is captured by a law enforcement agency or a
19	person who is under contract with or otherwise acting under the direction of
20	or on behalf of a law enforcement agency:
21	(A) In immediate pursuit of a person that law enforcement
22	officers have reasonable suspicion or probable cause to suspect has committed
23	an offense, not including misdemeanors or offenses punishable by a fine only;
24	(B) For the purpose of documenting a crime scene where an
25	offense, not including misdemeanors or offenses punishable by a fine only,
26	has been committed;
27	(C) For the purpose of investigating the scene of a:
28	(i) Human fatality;
29	(ii) Motor vehicle accident causing death or serious
30	bodily injury to a person; or
31	(iii) Motor vehicle accident on a state highway or
32	federal interstate or highway;
33	(D) In connection with the search for a missing person;
34	(E) For the purpose of conducting a high-risk tactical
35	operation that poses a threat to human life; or
36	(F) Of private property that is generally open to the

1	public where the property owner consents to law enforcement public safety
2	activities;
3	(9) If the image is captured by a state or local law enforcement
4	agency, or a person who is under contract with or otherwise acting under the
5	direction of or on behalf of a state or local law enforcement agency for the
6	<pre>purpose of:</pre>
7	(A) Surveying the scene of a catastrophe or other damage
8	to determine whether a state of emergency should be declared;
9	(B) Preserving public safety, protecting property, or
10	surveying damage or contamination during a lawfully declared state of
11	emergency; or
12	(C) Conducting routine air quality sampling and
13	monitoring, as provided by state or local law;
14	(10) At the scene of a spill, or a suspected spill, of hazardous
15	<pre>materials;</pre>
16	(11) For the purpose of fire suppression;
17	(12) For the purpose of rescuing a person whose life or well-
18	being is in imminent danger;
19	(13) If the image is captured by an Arkansas-licensed real
20	estate broker in connection with the marketing, sale, or financing of real
21	property, provided that no individual is identifiable in the image;
22	(14) From a height no more than eight feet (8') above ground
23	level in a public place, if the image was captured without using any
24	electronic, mechanical, or other means to amplify the image beyond normal
25	human perception;
26	(15) Of public real property or a person on the public real
27	<pre>property;</pre>
28	(16) If the image is captured:
29	(A) By the owner or operator of an oil, gas, water, or
30	other pipeline for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, or repairing
31	pipelines or other related facilities; and
32	(B) Without the intent to conduct surveillance on an
33	individual or real property;
34	(17) In connection with oil pipeline safety and rig protection;
35	<u>or</u>
36	(18) In connection with port authority surveillance and

1	security.
2	(c) This section does not apply to the manufacture, assembly,
3	distribution, or sale of an unmanned aircraft.
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
