4	and hemodialysis, including administering associated medications and central
5	venous catheter access and care, under the authority of a registered nurse
6	licensed in this state who may delegate tasks based on nursing judgment to a
7	dialysis patient care technician based on the dialysis patient care
8	technician's education, knowledge, training, and skill.

11	(a) To register as a dialysis patient care technician, an individual
12	shall:
13	(1) Possess a high school diploma or a general educational
14	development certificate;
15	(2) Demonstrate that he or she is:
16	(A) Employed as a dialysis patient care technician; or
17	(B) Enrolled in a training course that follows national
18	recommendations for dialysis patient care technicians and is conducted
19	primarily in the work setting;
20	(3)(A) Obtain national certification by successful passage of a
21	certification examination within eighteen (18) months of becoming employed as
22	a dialysis patient care technician.
23	(B)(i) A dialysis patient care technician shall recertify
24	national certification at intervals required by the organization providing
25	the certification examination.
26	(ii) The intervals required under subdivision
27	(a)(3)(B)(i) of this section shall include no fewer than thirty (30) and no
28	more than forty (40) patient contact hours since the previous certification
29	or recertification;
30	(4) Submit an application with the Arkansas State Board of

22	(a)(l) The Arkansas State Board of Nursing shall list each dialysis		
23	patient care technician registrant on a registry to be named the "Dialysis		
24	Patient Care Technician Registry".		
25	(2) A listing in the registry is valid for the term of the		
26	registration and upon renewal unless the listing is refused renewal or is		
27	removed.		
28	(b) The registry shall contain the following information on each		
29	person who is a registered dialysis patient care technician:		
30	(1) The individual's full name;		
31	(2) Any conviction of a felony or misdemeanor reported to the		
32	board;		
33	(3) A certificate showing completion of a nationally recognized		
34	training program; and		
35	(4) A certificate of completion of a nationally commercially		
36	available dialysis patient care technician certification examination.
