34	<u>As used in this</u>	<u>s subchapter, "dialysis patient care technician" means a</u>
35	person who meets the	requirements of § 17-87-905.

2	17-87-904. Tasks performed.
3	<u>A dialysis patient care technician may administer hemodialysis,</u>
4	including administering associated medications and central venous catheter
5	access and care, under the authority of a registered nurse licensed in this
6	<u>state who may delegate tasks based on nursing judgment to a dialysis patient</u>
7	care technician based on the dialysis patient care technician's education,
8	knowledge, training, and skill.

10	17-87-905. Registration.
11	(a) To register as a dialysis patient care technician, an individual
12	shall:
13	(1) Possess a high school diploma or a general educational
14	development certificate;
15	(2) Demonstrate that he or she is:
16	(A) Employed as a dialysis patient care technician; or
17	(B) Enrolled in a training course that follows national
18	recommendations for dialysis patient care technicians and is conducted
19	primarily in the work setting;
20	(3)(A) Obtain national certification by successful passage of a
21	certification examination within eighteen (18) months of becoming employed as
22	<u>a dialysis patient care technician.</u>
23	(B)(i) A dialysis patient care technician shall recertify
24	national certification at intervals required by the organization providing
25	the certification examination.
26	(ii) The intervals required under subdivision
27	(a)(3)(B)(i) of this section shall include no fewer than thirty (30) and no
28	more than forty (40) patient contact hours since the previous certification
29	or recertification;
30	(4) Submit an application with the Arkansas State Board of
31	Nursing; and
32	(5) Pay the applicable fee as determined by the board.
33	(b)(l) An applicant for registration as a dialysis patient care
34	technician shall report to the board, in writing, any conviction for a felony
35	<u>or misdemeanor.</u>
36	(2) A conviction is not a disqualification for registration

1	under this section unless the conviction relates to the criminal offenses						
2	listed in § 17-3-102.						
3	(c)(l) An applicant or a dialysis patient care technician may report						
4	any pardon or setting aside of a conviction to the board.						
5	(2) If a pardon or setting aside has been obtained, the						
6	conviction for which the pardon or setting aside was obtained shall not be						
7	maintained on the Dialysis Patient Care Technician Registry created under §						
8	<u>17-87-906.</u>						
9	(d) If a person registered as a dialysis patient care technician						
10	becomes licensed as a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse, his or						
11	her registration as a dialysis patient care technician shall terminate as of						
12	the date of licensure as a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse.

14	<u> 17-87-906. Dialysis Patient Care Technician Registry — Contents of</u>						
15	registry.						
16	(a)(l) The Arkansas State Board of Nursing shall list each dialysis						
17	patient care technician registrant on a registry to be named the "Dialysis						
18	Patient Care Technician Registry".						
19	(2) A listing in the registry is valid for the term of the						
20	registration and upon renewal unless the listing is refused renewal or is						
21	removed.						
22	(b) The registry shall contain the following information on each						
23	person who is a registered dialysis patient care technician:						
24	(1) The individual's full name;						
25	(2) Any conviction of a felony or misdemeanor reported to the						
26	board;						
27	(3) A certificate showing completion of a nationally recognized						
28	training program; and						
29	(4) A certificate of completion of a nationally commercially						
30	available dialysis patient care technician certification examination.

32	<u>17-87-907. Construction.</u>						
33	This subchapter does not:						
34	(1) Require a dialysis patient care technician to register as a						
35	medication assistive person under § 17-87-701 et seq.; or						
36	(2) Apply to a dialysis patient care technician who is working
