| 6 | (1) Of the goals of neuropsychological examination and his or |
| 7 | her specific role in achieving those goals; |
| 8 | (2) Through additional training, if necessary, of appropriate |
| 9 | institutional emergency procedures to deal with various medical emergencies |
| 10 | such as heart attack, respiratory arrest, and seizures and of other relevant |
| 11 | information; and |
| 12 | (3) (2) In addition to medical emergencies, of recommended |
| 13 | procedures for dealing with incompetent or adjudicated patients who attempt |
| 14 | to leave the testing setting without authorization. |

| 22 | confidentiality, mandatory reporting, best practices in objective test |
| 23 | administration, and scoring; |
| 24 | (B) A minimum of sixteen (16) hours in the study of test |
| 25 | manuals; |
| 26 | (C) A minimum of twenty (20) hours of direct observation |
| 27 | of test administration and scoring by a licensed psychologist; and |
| 28 | (D) A minimum of forty (40) hours of administering and |
