15	TO ESTABLISH AN EXEMPTION PROGRAM FOR
16	AMBULANCE SERVICE'S OPERATORS FOR
17	CERTAIN HEALTHCARE SERVICES.
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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-13-108(b), concerning the triage, treat,
22	and transport to alternative destination by an ambulance service operator, is
23	amended to read as follows:
24	(b) An Except as provided under subsection (c) of this section, an
25	ambulance service's operators may triage and transport a patient to an
26	alternative destination in this state or treat in place if the ambulance
27	service is coordinating the care of the patient through telemedicine with a
28	physician for a medical-based complaint or with a behavioral health
29	specialist for a behavioral-based complaint.
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31	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-13-108, concerning the triage, treat,
32	and transport to alternative destination by ambulance service operators, is
33	amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
34	(c)(l) The department shall by rule establish a procedure in which an
35	ambulance service's operator may apply for an exemption for certain
36	healthcare services from the telemedicine requirement under subsection (b) of



1	this section on the basis that the healthcare service does not necessitate
2	coordination of care of the patient through telemedicine.
3	(2) The department shall establish the criteria to be used in
4	determining whether or not a healthcare service is exempt under subdivision
5	(c)(l) of this section.
6	(3)(A) An ambulance service's operator may apply for an
7	exemption for a certain healthcare service under subdivision (c)(l) of this
8	section on forms prescribed by the department.
9	(B) A separate application shall be filed for each:
10	(i) Each Healthcare service for which the ambulance
11	service's operator seeks an exemption; and
12	(ii) Each application shall contain information on
13	which the ambulance service's operator relies to justify an exemption.
14	(4) Upon making a determination on an application for exemption,
15	the department shall notify the ambulance service's operator of the
16	department's determination.
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18	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Rules.</u>
19	(a) When adopting the initial rules required under this act, the
20	Department of Health shall file the final rules with the Secretary of State
21	for adoption under § 25-15-204(f):
22	(1) On or before January 1, 2026; or
23	(2) If approval under § 10-3-309 has not occurred by January 1,
24	2026, as soon as practicable after approval under § 10-3-309.
25	(b) The department shall file the proposed rules with the Legislative
26	Council under § 10-3-309(c) sufficiently in advance of January 1, 2026, so
27	that the Legislative Council may consider the rules for approval before
28	<u>January 1, 2026.</u>
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
